



Over the 25 years since it was established, the National Lottery has steadily increased its annual turnover. From sales of €130 million in its first nine months, accumulated sales now stand at €12,059 million.



Over €3 billion in Scratch Card Sales in 25 years

In 1987, National Lottery operations began with the 'Instant 3' Scratch Card. Sales of this Scratch Card in its first full year were €113 million. The loyalty of Scratch Card players has continued, and sales of Scratch Cards in 2011 were in excess of €158 million.

Since 2004, the EuroMillions game has shown substantial growth. Sales of over €59 million were recorded in its first full year. By 2011, sales of EuroMillions had surged to over €127 million. When added to the EuroMillions Plus game, combined sales in this game category were €170 million.

Chairman's Statement

Ráiteas an Chathaoirligh



It gives me great pleasure to report another successful year's operations at Ireland's National Lottery, where in 2011, despite the continuing difficult economic environment, we delivered €231.9 million for distribution by the Government to good causes.

Is ábhar mór sásaimh dom a thuairisciú go raibh bliain rathúil eile ag oibríochtaí Chrannchur Náisiúnta na hÉireann i 2011 agus, in ainneoin na tosca deacra eacnamaíochta leanúnacha, gur sholáthraíomar €231.9 milliún le dáileadh ag an Rialtas ar dhea-chúiseanna.

2011 was a significant year in the history of Ireland's National Lottery in that it marked the 25th year of winning for players and good causes throughout Ireland. What started as a relatively modest business in March 1987 with just one Scratch Card game and sales of €130 million has grown steadily to achieve total sales of over €12 billion over the first 25 years.

Importantly, the cumulative amount of money raised for good causes over that period was €3.9 billion, and €6.3 billion has been returned to Irish players in prizes. The overall return to the community, directly and indirectly, is a very significant 93% of sales demonstrating the strong benefit of Ireland's National Lottery initiative.

2011 Performance

National Lottery sales in 2011 were €761.4 million, representing a decrease of 1.4% compared to the previous year. This was achieved in a very challenging retail environment where the average decline in comparable spend was 5%.

Our players shared a total of €422.5 million in prizes, up from €419.9 million in 2010, resulting in a prize payout level of 55.5% of sales.

Lotto related draw games represented half of the National Lottery's overall turnover with sales of €379.1 million in 2011. This category included the Lotto sales of €282.2 million; Lotto Plus sales of €83.0 million and Lotto 5-4-3-2-1 sales of €13.9 million.

The launch of the additional Tuesday night draw and enhanced prize structure for EuroMillions provided a great stimulus to this game with sales increasing by 29% to €127.4 million in 2011. Sales of the associated EuroMillions Plus game also increased, growing from €33.2 million in 2010 to €43.0 million in the year under review.

Bliain shuntasach i stair Chranncur Náisiúnta na hÉireann ba ea 2011 sa mhéid gur shlánaigh sé 25 bliain de bhuanna d'imreoirí agus do dhea chuíseanna araon ar fud na hÉireann. Bhí fás leanúnach faoin ngnó sách measartha a bunafodh mí an Mhárta 1987, agus gan aige ach cluiche scríobchárta amháin le díolachán bliantúil de €130 milliún, agus tá díolachán de €12 billiún bainte amach aige sna 25 bliain tosaigh.

Rud tábhachtach is ea gur gnóthaíodh suim charnach de €3.9 billiún do dhea-chuíseanna le linn na tréimhse sin agus tugadh €6.3 billiún thar nais d'imreoirí Éireannacha i bhfoirm dhuaiseanna. Bé an mór-thoradh gur cuireadh céatadán suntasach den díolachán – 93% - ar fáil don phobal. Léiriú é seo ar an leas mór a bhaineann le tionscnamh Chranncur Náisiúnta na hÉireann.

Feidhmiúchán 2011

Bhí díolachán de €761.4 milliún ar an gCranncur Náisiúnta i 2011. Laghdú 1.4% é seo ar dhíolachán na bliana roimhe sin. Baineadh é seo amach in ainneoin an timpeallacht mhiondíola a bheith an-dhúshláin agus laghdú 5% a bheith ar chaiteachas inchomparáide.

Roinneadh duaiseanna dar luach €422.5 milliún ar ár n imreoirí. Méadú é seo ó €419.9 milliún i 2010 a d'fhág leibhéal duais-focaíochta de 55.5% den díolachán.

B'ionann cluichí a bhaineann le Lotto agus leath de láimhdeachas iomlán an Chranncuir Náisiúnta le díolachán de €379.1 milliún i 2011. Áirítear sa chatagóir seo díolachán Lotto de €282.2 milliún; díolachán ar Lotto Plus de €83.0 milliún agus díolachán de €13.9 milliún ar Lotto 5-4-3-2-1.

Ba spreagadh mór é do EuroMillions seoladh an chranncuir bhreise oíche Dé Máirt agus an duais-struchtúr feabhsaithe. Bhí méadú de 29% ar an díolachán go €127.4 milliún i 2011. Bhí méadú freisin ar dhíolachán an chluiche ghaolmhair, EuroMillions Plus agus d'fhás sé ó €33.2 milliún i 2010 go €43.0 milliún sa bliain atá faoi chaibidil.

Our focus on business efficiency and cost management continued in 2011 and delivered a further reduction in total costs from €108.4 million in 2010 to €107.0 million in the year under review.

Our Scratch Card game portfolio was invigorated during the year driving a successful performance of €158.4 million sales in 2011, up from €153.2 million. The introduction of an imaginative stream of new games, backed by a strong marketing campaign, was a key growth factor.

Sales of Monday Million and Monday Million Plus combined were €19.4 million compared to €20.6 million in 2010. The Monday Million game accounted for €13.8 million, with sales of Monday Million Plus up to €5.6 million from €3.7 million in its first full year of sales.

TellyBingo increased its popularity for the fourth consecutive year with a 16% increase in sales to €17.7 million in 2011, helped by the full year effect of the third weekly TV draw.

For 2011, we concentrated efforts on two seasonal limited edition Millionaire Raffle games for Easter and Christmas, achieving sales of €8.4 million in this game category.

All or Nothing, the National Lottery daily draw game achieved sales of €8.0 million during 2011.

Our online game sales increased by 63% to €6.1 million as this source of business continues to grow. We see potential for significant growth in this area through the ongoing development of the online product offering. However, we are conscious of continuing to do this in a socially responsible manner.

Operations

Our focus on business efficiency and cost management continued in 2011 and delivered a further reduction in total costs from €108.4 million in 2010 to €107.0 million in the year under review.

The other cost of sales category, including agents' commissions of €47.1 million, was €84.6 million in 2011, down from €86.2 million in the previous year, while administrative costs at €19.7 million represented just 2.6% of total sales.

B'ionann díolachán Monday Millions agus Monday Millions Plus le chéile agus €19.4 milliún i gcomparáid le €20.6 milliún i 2010. Ba ó chranncur Monday Millions a fuarthas €13.8 milliún de seo agus bhí méadú ar dhíolachán Monday Millions Plus go €5.6 milliún ó €3.7 milliún ina chéad bhliain iomlán díolaíochta.

Méadaíodh an t-éileamh ar TellyBingo don cheathrú bliain as a chéile agus díolachán de €17.7 milliún air i 2011, ar méadú é de 16%. Ba chabhair chuige seo éifeacht an tríú chranncuir sheachtainiúil le linn na bliana ar fad.

Le linn 2011 dhíromar ár n-iarrachtaí ar dhá chluiche séasúrach, ar eagrán teoranta de Millionaire Raffle iad, um Cháisc is um Nollaig. Baineadh amach díolachán de €8.4 milliún sa chatagóir seo cluchí.

Bhain All or Nothing, an cluiche laethúil de chuid an Chranncuir Náisiúnta, amach díolachán de €8.0 milliún le linn 2011.

Bhí méadú de 63% ar dhíolachán ar líne ár gcluichí go dtí €6.1 milliún agus leanann an foinse seo gnó de bheith ag fás. Feicimid féidearthachtaí suntasacha fáis sa réimse seo trí fhorbairt leanúnach a dhéanamh ar sholáthar tárgí ar líne. Ag an am céanna, tuigimid gur chóir é seo a dhéanamh ar dhóigh atá freagrach go sóisialta.

Oibríochtaí

Leanamar de bheith ag díriú ar éifeachtacht ghnó agus ar bhainistiú costas i 2011 agus bhaineamar amach laghdú breise ó €108.4 milliún i 2010 go dtí €107.0 milliún sa bhliain atá faoi chaibidil.

Bhí costais de €84.6 milliún sa chatagóir eile díolacháin, ar a n-áirítear coimisiún na ngníomhairí, le linn 2011. Laghdú é seo ó €86.2 milliún sa bhliain roimhe sin. Bhí costais riarracháin ann de €19.7 milliún, agus gan iontu ach 2.6% den díolachán iomlán.

The National Lottery management team and employees once again achieved an impressive increase in productivity with the addition of the new EuroMillions Tuesday draw to the existing game schedule. I would like to thank them for their hard work and continued commitment to the successful operation of the organisation during the year.

As chairman, I am grateful for the valuable support and advice I received from the National Lottery Board throughout 2011. In the course of the year Barbara Patton and James Hyland completed their terms of office and Michael Tyndall retired as company secretary. I would like to thank them all for their strong contribution to the organisation and welcome Jack Dempsey as the new company secretary.

Our shareholders, the Minister for Public Expenditure and Reform and An Post, continued to provide much appreciated direction and support for the continued development of the business.

As we celebrate the successful first 25 years of Ireland's National Lottery, we are mindful that the next licence process to operate the National Lottery is under review in 2012. I am confident that the unique success, experience and knowledge that reside in the organisation will play a valuable role in the next phase of Ireland's National Lottery. The strong brand equity, expert people and in-depth consumer understanding built up over 25 years place us in a unique position to participate in the continued generation of maximum funds for good causes in Ireland.

D'éirigh le foireann bainistíochta agus le fostaithe an Chrannchuir Náisiúnta feabhas suntasach ar tháirgíúlacht a bhaint amach trí chrannchur EuroMillions a chur leis an sceideal reatha clúichí le crannchur na Máirte. Ba mhaith liom buíochas a ghabháil leo as a ndiansaothar agus a dtiomantas leanúnach d'fheidhmiú rathúil na heagraíochta le linn na bliana.

Mar chathaoirleach, táim buíoch as an tacaíocht agus an chomhairle luachmhar a fuair mé ó Bhord an Chrannchuir Náisiúnta le linn 2011 ar fad. Le linn na bliana chríochnaigh Barbara Patton agus James Hyland a dtéarmaí oifige agus d'imigh Michael Tyndall ar scor ó bheith ina rúnaí cuideachta. Ba dheas liom buíochas a ghabháil leo uile as a sárshaothar don eagraíocht agus fáiltíú roimh Jack Dempsey mar rúnaí cuideachta nua.

Lean ár scairshealbhóirí, an tAire Caiteachas Phoiblí agus Athchóirithe agus An Post de bheith ag soláthar treorach agus tacaíochta, a raibh mórmheas orthu, agus as an ngnó a fhorbairt go leanúnach.

Agus an chéad 25 bliain rathúil de Chrannchur Náisiúnta na hÉireann á cheiliúradh againn is maith a thuigimid go bhfuil an chéad phróiseas ceadúnais eile chun an Crannchur Náisiúnta a reáchtáil le bheith faoi chaibidil i 2012. Táim suite de go mbeidh ról luachmhar ag an rath eisceachtúil, maille leis an taithí agus an t-eolas atá san eagraíocht, sa chéad ré eile de shaol Chrannchur Náisiúnta na hÉireann. Fágann luach láidir an bhranda, daoine saineolacha agus tuiscint dhomhain ar na custaiméirí, a tógadh thar 25 bliain, i rocht ar leith sinn chun bheith bainteach le tuilleamh oiread airgid agus is féidir do dhea-chúiseanna in Éirinn.

Review of Operations

We are very pleased to have delivered another strong performance in 2011, with sales of €761.4 million compared to €772.0 million in the previous year. This represents a marginal drop of 1.4% which is considerably lower than the overall 5% decline in retail sales during the year.

Our key challenge during the year was to maintain players' interest and excitement in our games by continuously reviewing and developing our portfolio. In this regard, the main innovation in 2011 was the introduction of a new Tuesday night EuroMillions draw and an enhanced prize structure for this game.

Players

The National Lottery has a strong loyal player base with two thirds of all adults playing our games on a regular basis. Our research consistently shows that our players broadly reflect national demographics. 63% of males and 64% of females over 18 years play regularly and the rate of play on a regional basis is in line with the population distribution.

During the year, 34.3 million winners of National Lottery games shared a total prize fund of €422.5 million, up from €419.9 million in the previous year. This represents an average prize payout of 55.5%, the highest ever return, in a particularly lucky year for players.

During 2011, the National Lottery paid out over €1 million in winnings every day of the year to our players. While the larger jackpot wins tend to grab the newspaper headlines, it's worth noting that over 800 players won prizes of €10,000 or more.

Lotto, Lotto Plus and Lotto 5-4-3-2-1 are our most popular games and continue to be our single biggest category representing 50% of total National Lottery sales in 2011.

Sales of the Lotto game during the year were €282.2 million compared to €322.2 million in 2010. The average rate of play per player positions our Lotto game as one of the highest in the world in terms of participation.

In the course of the year, there was a higher number of Lotto jackpot wins than statistically expected resulting in a lower number of rolls which had an impact on sales. In addition, with the introduction of the Tuesday night EuroMillions draw as part of our policy to expand the overall portfolio of games on offer, there was naturally some level of migration of players from the Wednesday Lotto draw.

We were delighted to see players winning more on Lotto during the year, as the jackpot was won more frequently than statistically expected. The return to players was 52% on Lotto with a total of €146.8 million won in prizes in 2011.

During the year we had 25 jackpot wins, and 23 players became millionaires. The size of individual jackpots was somewhat lower than usual, at an average of €4.1 million, 12.8% below the comparable figure of €4.7 million in 2010. There were two jackpots over €10 million during 2011.

The biggest single Lotto jackpot win of the year was €11 million won by the McIntyre family from Belmullet, Co. Mayo in September. Their lucky €4 Quick Pick ticket was purchased in Eurospar, Tallagh Road, Belmullet.

Starting with Valentine's Day when six Match 5 plus bonus winners also won €100,000 worth of diamonds each, we added €1 million to the jackpot on Saturday 19 March for St Patrick's weekend and again on Saturday 30 April for the May bank holiday weekend.

On Wednesday 27 July, the winner of the top jackpot prize had the additional attraction of a Jaguar XK convertible worth €150,000. The Lotto draw was broadcast live from Eyre Square, Galway that evening with this magnificent car on display. 88% of all Lotto players now opt to play Lotto Plus giving them two additional chances to win on top of their regular jackpot play. This game generated sales of €83.0 million in 2011.

During the year, the total Lotto Plus prize fund was €39.6 million. There were 13 winners of the top Lotto Plus 1 €350,000 prize, while 22 lucky winners claimed the €250,000 top prize on Lotto Plus 2. A further 129 players won Match 5 plus bonus prizes on Lotto Plus 1 and 114 players won similar prizes on Lotto Plus 2.

Lotto Plus players shared in the Valentine's Day promotion on 12 February whereby €100,000 worth of diamonds was added to Match 5 Plus bonus wins. A total of four lucky winners won this special prize – one on the Lotto Plus 1 game and the other three on the Lotto Plus 2 game.

Sales of Lotto 5-4-3-2-1 were similar to the previous year at €13.9 million, compared to €14.1 million.

The high prize payout level of 67% continued to attract players who shared a total of €9.3 million during the year.

The new draw and prize offering was launched on Tuesday 10 May, with a guaranteed €100 million Superdraw jackpot. This created great excitement across the nine European countries where EuroMillions is played. Again on 4 October, a €100 million Superdraw jackpot was a feature of the Tuesday night draw.

During 2011, the winning ticket for the biggest ever EuroMillions prize of €185 million was sold in the UK and was won by a lucky Scottish couple on Friday 8 July, when Colin and Christine Weir from Largs in Ayrshire collected this massive prize live on TV.

Sales of the associated EuroMillions Plus game also increased significantly, up 30% to €43.0 million from €33.2 million in 2010. In addition to the positive impact of changes to the main draw, a further growth factor here was the increase in the take up of the EuroMillions Plus game which grew to 67% of all EuroMillions players during the year.

The enhanced EuroMillions game was successfully supported by a strong marketing programme, including a new advertising campaign featuring the popular granny Peggy and her prize winning dreams. The high profile TV

Throughout the year, there were 13 winners of the top €500,000 EuroMillions Plus prize and over 100,000 cash prize winners per week across the two draws.

The number of regular EuroMillions players playing the Tuesday night draw as well as the Friday draw well exceeded expectations by the year end and we expect this figure to continue to increase as awareness of the Tuesday draw builds.

Importantly for Irish EuroMillions players and beneficiaries, similar to Lotto, one third of every euro spent on EuroMillions games goes directly to good causes in Ireland. This means that in 2011 over €50 million was returned to the Irish community, thanks to our EuroMillions players.

In 2011, Scratch Card players shared €106.4 million in prizes representing a 67% payout level. This higher level of return and a greater chance of winning a large number of prizes greatly appeals to our players, as does the unique suitability of Scratch Cards for gifting occasions.

As part of the innovation strategy for Scratch Cards, we launched 23 exciting new games in 2011 including Cluedo, Money Bunny and Hampers, Sweets & Treats where we were pleased to partner with Irish chocolate company, Butlers. Popular games such as All Cash, Bingo and Congratulations continued alongside the newer additions to the portfolio, whilst our Christmas Treasure card again proved very popular with players.

In keeping with our approach of offering a wide choice to our Scratch Card players, our ticket prices ranged from €1 to €10, depending on the card and the occasion.





National Lottery Play Online

The level of online sales was up 65% in 2011, increasing to €6.1 million from €3.7 million.

Launched in 2009, our focus to date for this online player base has been on ensuring that we meet the highest standards of responsible gaming and security.

During 2011, we continued to develop the choice of games available online, offering players nine new instant win games bringing the total number of games available to 15. Cash Blizzard, Diamond Mine and Safe Cracker were among the popular new games on offer.

Online players also had the convenience of being able to play the Lotto and EuroMillions draw games over the internet.

As awareness of the Play Online facility grew, the number of registered players increased to 27,200 by the end of 2011, up 79% from 15,200 in the previous year.

The biggest online winner in 2011 was a Lotto Plus 1 top prize of €350,000 won by a lucky player on Wednesday 31 August.

We envisage that the rate of growth for the National Lottery Play Online service will continue to develop as more players become aware of its convenience benefits. The enhancement of our website as a means of promoting the online play option was an important and successful development during the year.

We continue to work closely with our regulator in developing the online game options in a socially responsible manner.

Diamond Mine, an Instant Win game, was launched in 2011. An attractive top prize of €15,000 was on offer, as well as lots of other smaller prizes.

Operations

During 2011, the total number of individual transactions handled was over 250 million, close to 5 million transactions per week. We managed 1,168 individual draws and now have 27 regular game draws per week, up from 22 in 2010.

The cost of operating the National Lottery covers three main categories – prizes, which is by far the highest cost; other costs of sales and administrative costs.

In 2011, other costs of sales reduced from €86.2 million in 2010 to €84.6 million. This includes €47.1 million agents' commission representing 6% of total sales.

Administrative costs were €19.7 million compared to €19.4 million in 2010, reflecting the extra costs associated with the additional EuroMillions Tuesday draw.

The number of employees increased from 103 to 108, reflecting the additional support required for our increased game portfolio, sales and internet development. Sales per employee were over €7 million, higher than any other European lottery of a comparable size.

Over the course of the year, we worked closely with our network of over 3,780 retail agents and I'd like to take this opportunity to thank them for being the public face of the National Lottery and dealing with customers on our behalf. As a result of our ongoing retail upgrade, all stores now provide the full range of National Lottery games and nearly all have self-service ticket checkers installed. During 2011, a further 902 stores were upgraded to the improved broadband capability.

We now have live digital display screens in our top 1,000 retail outlets and plan to install a further 1,000 of these in 2012. This facility allows us to update jackpot amounts on a real time basis, highlight good causes and winners, and inform players of new products and promotions.

The staff of the National Lottery have been the driving force in the success of the business since its inception and in 2011 they continued to develop the business as we launched further game innovations, particularly in the EuroMillions game. I would like to thank all those working in the National Lottery for their significant contribution to a very busy year and another successful operations performance that firmly positions us as one of the top lotteries in the world.

National Lottery Operations

In 2010, the National Lottery handled 267 million individual transactions. National Lottery staff also managed 854 individual draws with 22 regular game draws each week.

Operating costs were reduced in 2010 by 4.3% to €108.4 million. The retail side of operations continued to grow and at the end of 2010, there were 3,813 retail agents.

Player support services were improved in 2010 with the installation of 930 self service ticket checkers. 950 stores were upgraded to improve broadband capability and the roll-out of digital display screens in top retail outlets continued.

Responsible Gaming

While we focus on enhancing and promoting our wide range of lottery games to new and existing players, we are committed to raising as much money as possible for good causes in a socially responsible way. We recognise that we have a duty of care to our players to ensure that National Lottery games do not encourage excessive play and that National Lottery tickets are not sold to persons under eighteen years of age. Responsible gaming is therefore a key area of focus for the Company.

We strive to protect vulnerable players and to prevent underage play through the implementation of various initiatives as part of our Responsible Gaming Policy. These initiatives include specific programmes in the areas of improved monitoring and reporting of responsible gaming issues; staff communication and training; game design protocols; agent communication and awareness; player information and awareness and Advertising and Marketing Codes of Conduct. We are intent on continuing these initiatives and programmes to help promote responsible gaming.

As part of our commitment to responsible gaming, we publish an annual report on our website of significant engagement activities and initiatives undertaken in the preceding 12 months. Our first report was published on our website during the year.

Our work in the area of responsible gaming has not gone unrecognised. The Company was presented with its Certificate of Alignment with European Lotteries Responsible Gaming Standard at the European Lotteries General Assembly in Helsinki on 8 June, 2011.

The men's race was won by Geoffrey Ndungu from Kenya setting a new course record of 2:08:33, while Helalia Johannes from Namibia won the women's race in 2:30:35.

As part of this sponsorship, we supported the popular preparatory Race Series for 5 mile, 10 mile and half Marathon runs in the Phoenix Park during the months of July, August and September. These were actively promoted by our race ambassador Kathryn Thomas.

We were delighted that the National Lottery involvement enabled the event to be carried live on RTE2 TV for the first time in 20 years which was a major boost to the event. There was also great support for the runners along the route as thousands of spectators came out to cheer them on.

Every year, hundreds of millions of euro raised by the National Lottery is distributed by government to sports projects, sports communities and individual sporting endeavours throughout Ireland. Many of Ireland's top athletes – like David Gillick and Derval O'Rourke – have received National Lottery beneficiary support to assist them in their sporting careers. In this context, we were pleased to have an opportunity to be associated with a major Irish sporting event such as the Dublin Marathon.

We also sponsored the spectacular National Lottery SkyFest which was staged in Wexford town in 2011 as part of the St Patrick's Festival celebrations. To add to the festivities, the National Lottery Lotto draw for Saturday 19 March took place on the Wexford quayside and was broadcast live on RTE TV.

Good Causes

In its 25th year of operations, I'm proud to report that the National Lottery raised a further €231.9 million for distribution by the Government to good causes all over the country. This brings the cumulative amount to over €3.9 billion since March 1987, leaving us well on track to break the €4 billion milestone in 2012.

Many projects in the categories of Health & Welfare; Youth, Sports, Recreation and Amenities; Arts, Culture and National Heritage and the Irish language all benefited from National Lottery funding in 2011.

Throughout the year, initiatives which received National Lottery funding were featured on the Winning Streak TV Gameshow, in The Spark – our good causes newsletter – and on the National Lottery website.

Sports projects have been a major beneficiary of the National Lottery since its establishment in 1987. In 2011, some examples of sports capital grants made from the National Lottery fund through the Department of Transport, Tourism and Sport included over €850,000 in funding towards the national snow sports centre in Kilternan, Co. Dublin. This is a centre of excellence for snow sports in Ireland and is used by thousands of skiers every year, including national teams and the Special Olympics team.

Roscrea Leisure Centre in Co. Tipperary received almost €1.7 million in 2011 to fund a multi-sports centre. This premier facility was part-funded by the National Lottery. Cumann Baile Setanta, a GAA Club in Ballymun, also received €400,000 in 2011 part-funded by the National Lottery, which was used to develop new club dressing rooms and an all-weather pitch.

Le linn na bliana tugadh suntas do thionscadail a fuair maoiniú ón gCrannchur Náisiúnta ar an Seóchluiche Teilifíse Winning Streak agus i The Spark - ár nuachtáitir faoi dhea-chúiseanna – agus ar shuíomh gréasán an Chranncuir Náisiúnta.

Fuair ionad Fóillíochta Ros Cré i dTíobraid Árann beagnach €1.7 milliún i 2011 chun lárionad ilspóirt a mhaoiniú. Fuair an tsar-áis seo páirt-mhaoiniú ón gCrannchur Náisiúnta. Fuair Cumann Báire Setanta, club de chuid CLG i mBaile Munna, €400,000 chomh maith i 2011 mar pháirt mhaoiniú chun seomraí gléasta nua don chlub agus páirc imeartha uile-aimsire a fhorbairt.

Aspiro was formed in September 1997 and quickly established itself as a unique and ambitious choir, promoting a world class model for choral music education practice in Ireland.

Funding by the National Lottery, through the Arts Council, has enabled Aspiro to fully develop and explore its artistic potential.

National Lottery funding was distributed to hundreds of initiatives including the Carlow Gymnastics Club; the Irish Table Tennis Association; St Michael's Rowing Club in Limerick and Cork soccer club Everton AFC. In addition, National Lottery funds also supported the Irish Olympic team in their preparations for the London 2012 games.

In Health, the voluntary organisation, Tuam Cancer Care was a recipient of National Lottery Beneficiary Funding, through the Department of Health and Children. The funding it received allowed this community support group make a significant step towards the development of a purpose built centre to deliver the best care in a homely and therapeutic environment.

Arts initiatives throughout Ireland continue to receive National Lottery funding through the Arts Council. The Limerick Youth Theatre, a company of young performers, dancers, writers, designers and producers was one such beneficiary.

In the Irish language category, the chart station Raidió Rí-Rá which is based in Dublin continued to bring Irish to young people through contemporary online and live broadcasts.

Letterkenny Regional Cultural Centre (RCC) is a world-class centre for visual and socially engaged arts, and it received €2.55 million funding towards its development from the National Lottery. The Regional Cultural Centre is acknowledged as one of the finest arts facilities in Ireland.

Opened in 2007, the RCC incorporates an exhibition gallery (250m²), a studio cinema / theatre, three multi-purpose workshop spaces, two dedicated film and digital media spaces and two music rehearsal rooms.

The RCC presents a year-long programme of national and international classical, jazz, traditional, world music concerts and youth rock gigs.

Roinneadh maoiniú ón gCrannchur Náisiúnta ar na céadta tionscadal ar a n áirítear Club Gleacaíochta Cheatharlach; Cumann Leadóige Boird na hÉireann; Club Rámhaíochta Mhichíl Naofa i Luimneach agus, an club sacair Corcaíoch Everton AFC. Thairis sin, úsáideadh maoiniú ón gCrannchur Náisiúnta chun tacú le foireann Oilimpeach na hÉireann agus iad ag ullmhú do na cluichí i Londain i 2012.

I réimse na Sláinte, fuair an eagraíocht dheonach, Tuam Cancer Care, maoiniú ó chiste thairbhithe an Chranncuir Náisiúnta tríd an Roinn Sláinte agus Leanaí. Chuir an maoiniú a fuaireadar ar chumas an ghrúpa tacaíochta pobail seo láirionad toiscdhéanta a forbairt ina gcuirfí scoth na haire ar fáil i dtimpeallacht thíríúil, theiripeach.

Leanann tionscadail ealaíne de bheith ag fáil maoiniú ón gCrannchur Náisiúnta tríd an gComhairle Ealaíon. Tá an Limerick Youth Theatre, complacht d'aisteoirí, rinceoirí, scríbhneoirí, dearthóirí agus léiritheoirí óga ar cheann de na tairbhithe.

The Irish Association of Youth Orchestras (IAYO) engages in artistic programming and training for orchestra conductors, organisers and young instrumentalists. In 2001, the IAYO received €85,000 from the Arts Council, which receives a large portion of its funding from the National Lottery Beneficiary Fund.

Its flagship event is the Festival of Youth Orchestras, held annually in the National Concert Hall in early February. The IAYO also assists in the management and administration of the Irish Youth Wind Ensemble and ConCorda Chamber Music courses which are held each summer. For younger players, the calendar highlight is a weekend of chamber music held annually at the end of April.

The Future An Toghacháí

Archways was established in 2006 as a national organisation to promote and research evidence-based programmes to support children and young people with emotional and behavioural difficulties. Archways rolls out a number of behavioural programmes including the Incredible Years Programme, The Mentoring for Achievement Programme, Functional Family Therapy and The Triple P Parenting Programme.

Archways received funds from the National Lottery, through government, to introduce the Incredible Years Infant Programme. This programme focuses on a child's first year of life and supports parents and their babies in a variety of ways.

The Directors have pleasure in submitting their twenty fifth annual report, together with the audited financial statements of the Company, for the year ended 31 December, 2011, in fulfilment of their obligations under the Companies Acts, 1963 to 2009.

1. The Company

The Company carries on the business of operating the National Lottery under Licence from the Minister for Public Expenditure and Reform in accordance with the provisions of the National Lottery Act, 1986

80% of the issued share capital is held by An Post and 20% is held by the Minister for Public Expenditure and Reform.

2. Results for the Year

The results for the year are set out on page 60.

3. Business Review

The information required by Section 13 of the Companies (Amendment) Act, 1986, on the development of the business and important events, is included in the Chairman's Statement and Review of Operations on pages 4 to 41.

As described therein, the Company had a substantial surplus of €232m in 2011 (2010: €244m) to the benefit of the Beneficiary Fund. This resulted from sales of €761m in 2011 (2010: €772m).

In monitoring the Company's performance, the Directors and management have regard to a range of key performance indicators (KPIs).

The above KPIs are within the terms of the Licence to operate the National Lottery.

The key risks and uncertainties facing the future development of the Company include the retention of the Company's licence to operate the National Lottery, the Company's significant reliance upon its IT infrastructure and retailer operations, the impact of general economic factors on the Company and the introduction of new games and channels. The Directors have developed a range of strategies to address these and other risks faced by the Company. The Corporate Governance Statement on page 47 sets out the Company's policies and approach to risks and the related internal control procedures and responsibilities.

4. Directors, Secretary and their interests

The Directors of the Company are appointed by the Minister for Public Expenditure and Reform for a fixed term, usually three years, and their conditions of appointment and fees are set out in writing.

The terms of office of Donal Connell, James Hyland and Barbara Patton expired on 5 November, 2011. Donal Connell was reappointed from that date.

Michael Tyndall retired as Company Secretary on 21 March, 2011 and Jack Dempsey was appointed Company Secretary on that date.

The Directors and Secretary who held office at 31 December, 2011 had no interest in the shares in, or debentures of, the Company or any Group Company.

Tá an t-eolas a éilítear faoi réir Alt 13 d'Acht na gCuideachtaí (Leasú) 1986, ar phorbairt an ghnó agus ar imeachtaí tábhachtacha, clúdaithe i Ráiteas an Chathaoirligh agus san Athbhreithníú Oibríochtaí ar leathanaigh 4 go 41.

Mar atá ráite ansin, bhí barrachas substaintiúil de €232m i 2011 (2010: €244m) agus cuireadh é chun leasa Chiste na dTairbhithe. D'eascair an toradh seo as díolachán de €761m i 2011 (2010: €772m).

Ar na heocair-ríoscaí agus na neamhchinneachtaí a gcaithfear aghaidh a thabhairt orthu, má táthar leis an gComhlacht a phorbairt, tá coinneáil cheadúnas an Chomhlachta chun an Crannchur Náisiúnta a rith, chomh móré is atá an Comhlacht i dtuilleamaí a infreastruchtúr TF agus a oibríochtaí miondóla, eifeacht tosca eacnamaíochta ginearálta ar an gComhlacht agus clúichí is cainéil nua do theacht isteach. Tá raon straitéisí forbartha ag na Stiúrthóirí chun plé leo seo agus le ríoscaí eile a gcaithfidh an Comhlacht aghaidh a thabhairt orthu. Tháinig tréimhsí oifige Donal Connell, James Hyland agus Barbara Patton chun críche ar 5 Samhain, 2011. Athcheapadh Donal Connell le feidhm ón dáta sin.

D'éirigh Michael Tyndall as bheith ina Rúnaí Cuideachta ar 21 Márta, 2011 agus ceapadh Jack Dempsey mar Rúnaí Cuideachta le feidhm ón dáta sin.

Ní raibh leas tairbhiúil, scaireanna sa Chomhlachta ná bintíúir a bhain leis nő le haon Ghrúp Chuideachta ag na Stiúrthóirí ná ag an Rúnaí a bhí in oifig ar 31 Nollaig, 2011.

Tuarascáil na Stiúrthóirí

5. Employees

The Company and An Post, which provides seconded staff to the Company, are equal opportunities employers. All applications for employment are given full and fair consideration, due regard being given to the aptitude and ability of the individual and the requirements of the position concerned.

All persons are treated on equal terms as regards training, career development and promotion.

The well-being of staff working in the Company is safeguarded through the strict adherence to health and safety standards. The Safety, Health and Welfare at Work Act, 2005 imposes certain requirements in respect of staff and the Company has taken the necessary action to ensure compliance with the Act, including the adoption of a Safety Statement.

6. Corporate Governance

Maintaining high standards of corporate governance continues to be a priority of the Directors of An Post National Lottery Company. The Board has developed its corporate governance policy so as to give effect to the Code of Practice for the Governance of State Bodies issued by the Department of Finance and to apply as appropriate the relevant main and supporting principles of good governance in the UK Corporate Governance Code dated June 2010 (the 'Code') issued by the Financial Reporting Council in the UK.

While the provisions of the Code are of direct relevance only to listed companies, the Board feels that their application, where appropriate, assists the Company in its compliance with best corporate governance practice.

The Directors are accountable to the shareholders for good corporate governance and this report addresses how the relevant main and supporting principles of the Code of Best Practice for the Governance of State Bodies and the Code have been applied within An Post National Lottery Company.

The Board

The Company is controlled through its Board of Directors. The Board's main roles are to oversee the operation of the Company, to provide leadership to the Company, to approve the Company's strategic objectives and to ensure that the necessary financial and other resources are made available to enable them to meet those objectives. The Board, which meets monthly during the year, has a schedule of matters reserved for its approval.

The specific responsibilities reserved to the Board include: setting Company strategy and approving an annual budget and medium-term projections; reviewing operational and financial performance; approving major capital expenditure; ensuring compliance with the terms of the licence to operate the National Lottery, reviewing the Company's systems of financial control and risk management; ensuring that appropriate management development and succession plans are in place; reviewing the environmental, health and safety performance of the Company; approving the appointment of the Company Secretary; and ensuring that a satisfactory dialogue takes place with shareholders.

The Board has delegated the following responsibilities to management: the development and recommendation of strategic plans for consideration by the Board that reflect the longer-term objectives and priorities established by the Board; implementation of the strategies and policies of the Company as determined by the Board; monitoring of the operating and financial results against plans and budgets; development of controls over the operation of draws, prioritising the allocation of technical and human resources; and developing and implementing risk management systems.

5. Fostaithe

Fostoirí comhdhaisead iad an Comhlacht agus An Post, a sholáthraíonn foireann ar shealscarúint don Chomhlacht. Cuirtear gach iarratas ar fhostaíocht san áireamh go hiomlán agus go cothrom agus tugtar aird chuí ar mhianach agus ar chumas an duine agus ar riachtanais an phoist atá i gceist.

Caitear le gach duine ar bhonn cothrom chomh fada is a bhainneann sé le hoiliúint, le forbairt gairme agus le hardú céime a thabhairt.

Déantar cúram d'ea-bhaili na foirme, atá ag obair leis an gComhlacht trí chloí go doch le caighdeán shábháilteachta agus sláinte. Leagann An tAcht um Shábháilteachta, Sláinte agus Leas ag an Obair, 2005, dualgais áirithe i leith na foirne agus tá na céimeanna riachtanacha glactha ag an gComhlacht chun déanamh de réir an Acharta. Áirítear orthusan glacadh le Ráiteas Sábháilteachta.

6. Rialachas Corparáide

Tosaíocht é ag Stiúrthóirí Chomhlacht Chranncur Náisiúnta an Phoist ardchaighdeán rialachais chorparáide a choinneáil.

D'fhobair an Bord a pholasáí ar rialachas corparáide le go mbeadh feidhm ag an gCód Cleachtas um Rialachas Chomhlachtaí Stáit a d'eisigh an Roinn Airgeadais agus chun feidhm a thabhairt nuair is cuí do phríomhphriónsabail agus do phriónsabail thacaíochta ábhartha um dhea-rialachas atá i Corporate Governance Code na Ríochta Aontaithe dar dáta Meitheamh 2010 (an 'Cód') a d'eisigh an Financial Reporting Council sa Ríocht Aontaithe.

Siúd is go mbaineann forálacha an Chomhchóid go díreach le cuideachtaí liostáilte amháin, braitheann an Bord go gcuideann a bhfeidhmí mar is cuí leis an gComhlacht chun sár cheachtas rialachais corparáide a chomhlíonadh.

Tá na Stiúrthóirí freagrach do na scairshealbhóirí as dearialachas corparáide agus pléann an tuarascáil seo leis an tsúl inar cuireadh i bhfeidhm na príomhphriónsabail agus na priónsabail thacaíochta ábhartha atá le fail sa Chóid Sár-cheachtas um Rialachas Chomhlachtaí Stáit agus sa Chomhchóid i gcás Chomhlacht Chranncur Náisiúnta an Phoist.

An Bord

Rialaítear an Comhlacht trína Bhord Stiúrtha. Is iad príomhróil an Bhoird maoirseach a dhéanamh ar oibríochtaí an Chomhlachta, cinnireacht a sholáthar don Chomhlacht, cuspóirí straitéisearach a Chomhlachta a fhaomhadh agus deimhin a dhéanamh de go gcuirtear ar fáil na hacmhainní riachtanacha airgeadais agus eile chun gur féidir leo na cuspóirí sin a bhaint amach. Uair sa mhí a thagann an Bord le chéile le linn na bliana. Tá sceideal ábhar atá forchoimeádta le faomhadh ag an mBord.

I measc na sainfhreagrachtaí atá forchoimeádta don Bhord tá: straitéis an Chomhlachta a cheapadh agus an buiséad bliantúil agus na réamh-mheastacháin mheántéarmacha a fhaomhadh; feidhmí oibríoch agus airgeadais a athbhreithniú; mórchaiteachas caipítíl a fhaomhadh; deimhin a dhéanamh de go bhfuil téarmaí an cheadúnais chun an Crannchur Náisiúnta a reáchtáil a gcomhlíonadh; córais an Chomhlachta um rialú airgeadais agus bainistiú riosca a athbhreithniú; deimhin a dhéanamh de go bhfuil pleannanna cuí i bhfeidhm chun forbairt agus comharbaíocht na bainistíochta a chinntí; feidhmí an Chomhlachta ó thaobh na timpeallachta agus cursaí sláinte is sábháilteachta de a athbhreithniú; ceapadh Rúnaí an Chomhlachta a fhaomhadh; deimhin a dhéanamh de go mbíonn idirphlé sásúil ann leis na scairshealbhóirí.

Tá na freagrachtaí seo a leanas tarmligthe ag an mBord don bainistíocht: pleannanna straitéisearach, a bheadh ag teacht le cuspóirí agus le tosaíochtaí fadtéarmacha an Bhoird, a cheapadh agus a mhíoladh don Bhord le scrúdú; straitéisí agus polasaithe an Chomhlachta, mar atá sonraithe ag an mBord, a feidhmí; faireachán a dhéanamh ar thorthaí oibríocha agus airgeadais i gcomparáid le pleannanna agus le buiséid; córais rialaithe a forbairt do reáchtáil na gcrannchur, tosaíochtaí a cheapadh do chionroinnt acmhainní daonna teicniúla; agus córais bainistíochta riosca a cheapadh is a chur i bhfeidhm.

The roles of the Chairman and Chief Executive

The Chairman leads the Board in the determination of its strategy and in the achievement of its objectives. The Chairman is responsible for organising the business of the Board, ensuring its effectiveness and setting its agenda. The Chairman facilitates the effective contribution of non-executive Directors and constructive relations between the executive Director and non-executive Directors, ensures that Directors receive accurate, timely and clear information and manages effective communication with shareholders.

The Chief Executive has direct charge of the Company on a day to day basis and is accountable to the Board for the financial and operational performance of the Company.

Senior Independent Director

The Board has considered the matter of designating a recognised senior member other than the Chairman to whom concerns can be conveyed and, in view of the manner of appointment of Directors, the shareholding structure and existing Board procedures, has concluded it is not necessary in the circumstances.

Directors and Directors' independence

The Board currently comprises the Chairman, five non-executive Directors and the Chief Executive. The names of the Directors together with their biographical details are set out on pages 42 and 43. The positions of Chairman and Chief Executive are held by different persons. Given its status as a State Company, its shareholding structure and the appointment of the Directors by the Minister, the Board believes that the criteria normally used by the board of a listed Company in considering the independence of its Directors do not apply to the Company. The Board includes independent non-executive Directors who constructively challenge and help develop proposals on strategy, bring strong, independent judgement, knowledge, and experience to the Board's deliberations. These independent Directors are of sufficient calibre and number that their views carry significant weight in the Board's decision making.

All of the non-executive Directors are independent of management. During the year, the Board included both the Chief Executive of the Company's parent company, An Post, as Chairman and James Hyland, a non-executive director of An Post. The Board considers all other non-executive Directors to be independent on the basis of the following:

- they have not been an employee of the Company;
- they have no material business relationship with the Company, nor have they had any within the last three years;
- they receive no remuneration other than through Director's fees;
- they have no close family ties with any of the Company's advisers, Directors or senior employees; and
- they hold no cross-directorships and have no significant links with other Directors through involvement in other companies or bodies.

Ról an Chathaoirligh agus an Phríomhfeidhmeannaigh

Is é An Cathaoirleach a threoraíonn an Bord maidir le cinneadh polasaí agus le baint amach a chuid cuspóirí. Is é an Cathaoirleach atá freagach as gnó an Bhoird a eagrú, as a éifeacht a chinntí agus as an clár gnó a shocrú. Éascaíonn an Cathaoirleach rannpháirtíocht éifeachtach na Stiúrthóirí neamh-fheidhmiúchán agus deachaidreamh idir iad agus an Stiúrthóirí feidhmiúchán agus cinníonn sé go bhfaigheann na Stiúrthóirí eolas cruinn, tráthúil agus soiléir. Bainistíonn sé freisin cumarsáid éifeachtach leis na scairshealbhóirí.

Is ag an bPríomhfeidhmeannach atá údarás díreach ar an gComhlacht ó lá go chóile agus tá sé freagach don Bhord as feidhmiú oibríoch agus airgeadais an Chomhlachta.

Stiúrthóir Sinsearach Neamhspleách

Scrúdaigh an Bord an fhéidearthacht go gceapfaí comhalta sinsearach inaiteanta, seachas an Cathaoirleach, mar dhuine go bhféadfaí ábhair imní a chur faoina bhráid agus i ngeall ar an tslí ina gceaptar Stiúrthóirí, struchtúr an scairchaipítil agus gnáthaimh reatha an Bhoird, shocraigh an Bord nach mbeadh a leithéid de shocrú riachtanach faoi na cúinsí sin.

Stiúrthóirí agus Neamhspleáchas na Stiúrthóirí

San am i láthair, is iad comhaltaí an Bhoird an Cathaoirleach, cíigear Stiúrthóir neamh fheidhmiúchán agus an Príomhfeidhmeannach. Tá ainmneacha na Stiúrthóirí mar aon lena sonraí beathaisnéise leagtha amach ar leathanaigh 42 agus 43. Daoine difriúla atá i bpost an Chathaoirligh agus i bpost an Phríomhfeidhmeannaigh. Nuaire a chuirtear san áireamh gur comhlachta Stáit atá i gceist, struchtúr an scairchaipítil agus gurb é an tAire a cheapann na Stiúrthóirí, measann an Bord nach dtagann na gnáth-chritéir, a d'úsáidfeadh stiúrthóirí chuideachta liostáilte chun neamhspleáchas a Stiúrthóirí a mheas, i bhfeidhm sa chás seo. Áirítear ar an mBord Stiúrthóirí neamh-fheidhmiúchán neamhspleácha a cheistíonn ar bhealach dearfach moltaí faoi chúrsáí straitéise agus a chabhraíonn le hiad a forbairt. Thairis sin, tugann siad breithiúnas láidir, neamhspleách, maillé le heolas agus taithí agus ceisteanna á scrúdú ag an mBord. Tá na Stiúrthóirí neamhspleácha líonmhára dhóthain agus de chraigdeán sách ard le go mbeadh tionchar nach beag ag a dtuairimí ar chinní an Bhoird.

Tá na Stiúrthóirí neamh-fheidhmiúchán uile neamhspleách ar an mbainistíocht. Le linn na bliana seo ghabh tharaínn, ba chomhaltaí den Bhord iad príomhfeidhmeannach mháthair-chuideachta an Chomhlachta, An Post, atá ina Cathaoirleach, agus James Hyland, stiúrthóir neamh fheidhmiúchán ar An Post. Measann an Bord na Stiúrthóirí neamh fheidhmiúchán eile a bheith neamhspleách ar na cíuseanna seo a leanas:

- nár bh fhostaí ag an gComhlacht iad;
- nach bhfuil aon ghaol gnó ábhartha acu leis an gComhlacht agus nach raibh aon ghaol den chineál sin acu le trí bliana anuas;
- nach bhfuil aon luach saothair, seachas a dtáillí mar Stiúrthóirí, á fháil acu;
- nach bhfuil aon ghaol gairid clainne acu le haon chomhairleoir, stiúrthóir nō fostaí sinsearach de chuid an Chomhlachta; agus
- nach bhfuil tras-stiúrthóireachtaí acu ná aon cheangal suaithínseach le Stiúrthóirí eile trí chuídeachtaí nō comhlachtaí eile.

Report of the Directors

The National Lottery Act, 1986, prescribes that the number of directors of the Company shall be seven. The authority regarding selection, nomination and appointment of the Directors is directly vested with the Company's shareholders. As such considerations such as board composition, board appointments and board renewal rest with the Company's shareholders rather than with the Board.

The Code requires the Chairman to hold meetings with the non-executive Directors without the executive Director being present. The Board has formal procedures in place in this regard.

Directors have the right to ensure that any concerns they have, which cannot be resolved, about the running of the Company or a proposed action, are recorded in the Board minutes. In addition, upon resignation, a non-executive Director will be asked to provide a written statement to the Chairman, for circulation to the Board, if they have any such concerns.

The Directors are given access to independent professional advice at the Company's expense, when the Directors deem it is necessary in order for them to carry out their responsibilities.

Professional development

On appointment, all new Directors take part in an induction programme when they receive information about the Company, the role of the Board and the matters reserved for its decision, the terms of reference and membership of the Board and its principal committees, the Company's corporate governance practices and procedures, including the responsibilities delegated to Company senior management, and the latest financial information about the Company. This will typically be supplemented by meetings with key senior executives. Throughout their period in office, the Directors are continually updated on the Company's business, the competitive and regulatory environments in which it operates, corporate social responsibility matters and other changes affecting the Company and the lottery industry as a whole, by written briefings and meetings with senior executives. Directors are also advised on appointment of their legal and other duties and obligations as a Director, both in writing and in face-to-face meetings with the Company Secretary. They are also updated on changes to the legal and governance requirements of the Company and upon themselves as Directors.

Performance evaluation

All Directors are appointed to the Board by the Minister for Public Expenditure and Reform in accordance with Section 14 of the National Lottery Act, 1986 and their terms of office (generally three years) are set out in writing.

The Board has adopted and performed a formal process for the annual evaluation of the performance of the Board and its principal Committees. The Board considers that the introduction of any further formal evaluation of individual Directors is not necessary given the manner of appointment of Directors, the shareholding structure and existing Board procedures. During the year, an evaluation of the performance of the Board was conducted.

Tuarascáil na Stiúrthóirí

Leagtar amach faoi phorálacha an Acharta um Chranncur Náisiúnta, 1986 gurb é seachtar líon na stiúrthóirí ar an gComhlacht. Tá an t údarás a bhaineann le roghnú, ainmniú agus ceapadh na Stiúrthóirí dílsithe i scairshealbhóirí an Chomhlachta. Baineann aon cheist, dála comhdhéanamh an Bhoird, ceapachán ar an mBord nó athnuachan an Bhoird, le scairshealbhóirí an Chomhlachta seachas leis an mBord.

Faoi gComhchód tá dualgas ar an gCathaoirleach cruinnithe a bheith aige leis na Stiúrthóirí neamh-fheidhmiúchán gan an Stiúrthóir feidhmiúchán a bheith i láthair. Tá gnáthaimh fhoirmiúla chuige seo i bhfeidhm ag an mBord.

Tá sé de cheart ag Stiúrthóirí deimhin a dhéanamh de go gclártaítear i miontuaíriscí an Bhoird aon ábhar inní gan réiteach atá acu faoi reáchtáil an Chomhlachta nó faoi bheart atá molta. De bhréis air sin, iarrfar ar aon Stiúrthóir neamh-fheidhmiúchán a eírfonn as oifig, ráiteas i scribhinn a thabhairt don Chathaoirleach, le cur thart ar an mBord, má tá aon ábhar inní aige.

Cuirtear comhairle neamhspleách phrofisiúnta ar fáil do na Stiúrthóirí ar chostas an Chomhlachta má shíleann na Stiúrthóirí go bhfuil gá lena leithéid le go bhfeadfaidís a gcuid dualgas a chomhlónadh.

Forbairt Phrofisiúnta

Tá an Bord den tuairim nach mbeadh aon mheastóireacht fhoirmiúil bhreise ar Stiúrthóirí aonair riachtanach nuair a chuirtear san áireamh an tsúl ína gceaptar Stiúrthóirí, an struchtúr scairsheilbhe agus a gnáthaimh atá ag an mBord faoi láthair. Le linn na bliana, rinneadh meastóireacht ar fheidhmiú an Bhoird.

The Company Secretary

The Company Secretary is a full time employee of the Company's parent company, An Post. The Company Secretary is responsible for advising the Board, through the Chairman, on all governance matters. All Directors have access to the advice and services of the Company Secretary. The Company's Articles of Association provide that the appointment and removal of the Company Secretary is a matter for the full Board.

Information

Regular reports and papers are circulated to the Directors in a timely manner in preparation for Board and Committee meetings. These papers are supplemented by information specifically requested by the Directors from time to time.

The non-executive Directors receive monthly management accounts and regular management reports and information which enables them to scrutinise the Company's and management's performance against agreed objectives.

Relations with shareholders

The Board and management maintain an ongoing dialogue with the Company's shareholders on strategic issues. In addition, under the National Lottery Act, 1986, certain operational matters require the approval of the Minister for Public Expenditure and Reform in respect of which ongoing contact with the Minister is maintained.

The Chairman gives feedback to the Board on issues raised with him by the shareholders. All Directors normally attend the Annual General Meeting and shareholders are invited to ask questions during the meeting and to meet with Directors after the formal proceedings have ended.

Internal Control and Risk Management

An ongoing process exists for identifying, evaluating and managing the significant risks faced by the Company. This process, which is based on the Code Guidance for directors issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants in England and Wales (the Turnbull Guidance), is periodically reviewed by the Directors and has been in place throughout the accounting period and up to the date the financial statements were approved.

In accordance with the guidance of the Turnbull committee, the Directors are responsible for the Company's system of internal control, should set appropriate policies on internal control, should seek regular assurance that will enable them to satisfy themselves that the system is functioning effectively and should ensure that the system of internal control is effective in managing risks in the manner which it has approved. Such a system is designed to manage rather than eliminate business risks and can provide only reasonable rather than absolute assurance against material misstatement or loss.

The Directors have continued to review the effectiveness of the Company's system of financial and non-financial controls, including operational and compliance controls, risk management and the Company's high level internal control arrangements. These reviews have included an assessment of internal controls by management, management assurance of the maintenance of controls, reports from the internal auditor and reports from the external auditor on matters identified in the course of its statutory audit work.

The Company views the careful management of risk as a key management activity. Managing business risk to deliver opportunities is a key element of all activities. This is done using a simple and flexible framework which provides a consistent and sustained way of implementing the Company's values. These business risks, which may be strategic, operational, reputational, financial or environmental, should be understood and visible. The business context determines in each situation the level of acceptable risk and controls.

Report of the Directors

The key risks facing the Company, as identified on page 46, have been considered throughout the year by the Board and management. The management of these risks includes frequent interaction with the Company's shareholders, identification of measures to mitigate the risks identified and consideration of contingency measures. External advisors have been consulted in this regard as required.

Management is responsible for the identification and evaluation of significant risks and for the design and implementation of appropriate internal controls. These risks are assessed on an ongoing basis and are derived from a variety of external and internal sources. Management reports regularly to the Board on the key risks inherent in the business and on the way in which these risks are managed. Management also reports to the Board on any significant changes in the Company's business and on any risks associated with such changes. The process used to identify and manage key risks is an integral part of the internal control environment.

The key procedures which the Directors have established with a view to providing effective internal control are as follows:

- A clear focus on business objectives as determined by the Board after consideration of the statutory responsibilities and risk profile of the Company's business.
- A defined organisational structure with clear lines of responsibility, delegation of authority and segregation of duties designed to foster a beneficial control environment.
- A risk management process which considers the strategy and development of the business in the context of the annual budget process when financial plans and performance targets are set and reviewed by the Board in light of the Company's overall objectives.

Tuarascáil na Stiúrthóirí

- A report and control system which produces a comprehensive set of financial reports. The annual budget is approved by the Board. Key financial statistics are monitored by management on a daily basis. Actual results are reported monthly against budget and any significant adverse variances are examined and remedial action taken.
- Control procedures – comprehensive procedures manuals are maintained by the Company in respect of all its main activities. In particular, there are clearly defined limits and procedures for financial expenditure, including procurement and capital expenditure, and for all draw operations.
- Monitoring system – compliance with control objectives is monitored on an ongoing basis by management. The control system is also monitored by internal audit whose work is focused on the areas of greatest risk to the Company.

The Company has procedures to ensure that appropriate arrangements are in place for employees to be able to raise, in confidence, matters of possible impropriety, with suitable subsequent follow-up action. Reporting channels have been created whereby perceived wrongdoing may be reported orally and via post, telephone and email, anonymously if preferred.

- determines the remuneration and other terms and conditions of employment of the Chief Executive;
- determines the pay structures and terms and conditions of other senior personnel;
- takes all decisions related to pay and pay related matters; and
- considers any other matters which it deems to be relevant to the foregoing.

The disclosures made in these financial statements (note 5) relating to Directors' emoluments and pension information are those required under the Irish Companies Acts, 1963 to 2009.

Report of the Directors

The Audit & Risk Committee

During the year, the Audit & Risk Committee comprised of Micheál Ó Muircheartaigh and up to 5 November, 2011, James Hyland and Barbara Patton, and from 28 November, 2011, Caroline Murphy and Donal Connell. Micheál Ó Muircheartaigh currently acts as Chairman of the Committee. All the members of the Committee are independent non-executive Directors.

Members of the Committee bring to it a wide range of experience from senior positions in business.

Under its terms of reference, the Audit & Risk Committee monitors the integrity of the Company's financial statements. The Committee is responsible for monitoring the effectiveness of the external audit process and making recommendations to the Board in relation to the appointment, re-appointment and remuneration of the external auditors. It is responsible for ensuring that an appropriate relationship between the Company and the external auditors is maintained, including reviewing non-audit services and fees. As a result of regulatory or similar requirements, it is necessary to employ the Company's external auditors for certain audit related and non-audit services. In order to maintain the independence of the external auditors, the Committee has determined policies as to what audit related and non-audit services can be provided by the Company's external auditors and the approval process related to these services. In particular, the Board considers it appropriate that independent observer and draw related services, which are the principal constituent of audit related fees paid, be performed by the external auditors. Under these policies, work of a consultancy nature will not be offered to the external auditors unless there are clear efficiencies and value added benefits to the Company while ensuring that the objectivity and independence of the external auditors is maintained. The Committee monitors the level of fees paid to the external auditors.

The Committee reviews annually the Company's systems of internal control and the processes for monitoring and evaluating the risks facing the Company.

The Committee meets with management, as well as privately with the external auditors.

In 2011, the Committee discharged its responsibilities by:

- reviewing the Company's draft financial statements prior to Board approval and meeting and reviewing with the external auditors their reports thereon;
- reviewing the appropriateness of the Company's accounting policies;
- reviewing the potential impact on the Company's financial statements of significant matters;
- reviewing the resources of internal audit, approving the internal audit plans, reviewing internal audit reports and dealing with control issues raised by the internal auditors;
- reviewing and approving the audit fee and reviewing non-audit fees payable to the Company's external auditors;
- reviewing the external auditors' plan for the audit of the Company's financial statements, confirmations of auditor independence and the proposed audit fee, and approving the terms of engagement for the audit;
- considering the adequacy of the Company's system of risk identification and assessment;
- considering the key risks faced by the Company, such as the retention of the licence to operate the National Lottery, the integrity of operations and the impact of the economy on the Company, and the measures in place to mitigate the risks;
- reviewing an annual report on the Company's systems of internal control and its effectiveness, reporting to the Board on the results of the review and receiving regular updates on key risk areas of financial control.

The Directors have reviewed the Company's business plan and other relevant information including the terms of the licence extension granted by the Minister for Public Expenditure and Reform to the Company for the operation of the National Lottery until 30 June, 2013. On that basis, the Directors have a reasonable expectation that the Company will continue in operational existence for the foreseeable future. For this reason, the Directors continue to adopt the going concern basis in preparing the financial statements.

Accounting Records

The Directors believe that they have complied with the requirements of Section 202 of the Companies Act, 1990 with regard to books of account by employing accounting personnel with appropriate expertise and by providing adequate resources to the financial function. The books of account of the Company are maintained at An Post National Lottery Company Headquarters, Lower Abbey Street, Dublin 1.

Accounting Policies

The following accounting policies have been applied consistently in dealing with items which are considered material in relation to the Company's financial statements.

1. Basis of Accounting

The financial statements are prepared under the historical cost convention in accordance with applicable law and Irish Generally Accepted Accounting Practice which includes compliance with the financial reporting standards of the UK Accounting Standards Board as promulgated by The Institute of Chartered Accountants in Ireland.

2. Turnover

Turnover from the sale of National Lottery tickets is recognised as the tickets are sold, with adjustments being made for Scratch Card ticket stocks held by agents and for multi draw tickets / advance tickets.

All turnover is derived from and originates in Ireland.

3. Prizes

The prize structure complies with the requirements of Section 4(2) of the National Lottery Act, 1986 whereby, taking one year with another, not less than 40% of the total monies received by the Company in respect of the sale of National Lottery tickets shall be distributed in prizes. Prizes are provided for as revenue is recognised on the basis of the game's particular prize structure. Any difference between the total amount provided and the amounts actually distributed is included in Creditors in the balance sheet.

4. Advertising and Promotional Expenditure

Advertising and promotional expenditure is written off in full in the year in which the costs are incurred.

5. Leased Assets – Operating

Operating lease rentals are charged to the Profit and Loss Account on a straight line basis over the lease term.

6. Taxation

The Company is exempt from Corporation Tax under Section 220 Taxes Consolidation Act, 1997.

7. Fixed Assets – Tangible Assets

Tangible assets are shown as having no book value, as the total cost thereof to the Company is reimbursed out of the National Lottery Fund.

Accordingly, no depreciation is provided.

Under Section 17(1) (a) of the National Lottery Act, 1986, the Company holds these assets in trust for the State.

8. Fixed Assets – Financial Assets

Financial fixed assets are shown at cost less provisions for impairments in value. Income from financial fixed assets is recognised in the Profit and Loss Account in the year in which it is receivable.

9. Stocks

Stocks comprise Scratch Card ticket stocks and are valued at cost. Cost includes import duties, V.A.T. and transport costs. All unusable and obsolete stock is written off.

Polasaithe Cuntasáiochta

2. Láimhdeachas

Aithnítear an láimhdeachas ó dhíolachán thicéid an Chranncuir Náisiúnta de réir mar a dhíoltar na ticéid agus déantar coigeartuithe don stoc ticéad scríobchártaí a choinníonn na gníomhairí agus do thicéid/réamh-thicéid-ilchrannchuir.

As Éirinn a thagann agus is in Éirinn a fhaightear an láimhdeachas uile.

3. Duaiseanna

Tá an duais-struchtúr ag teacht le forálacha Alt 4(2) den Acht um Chranncuir Náisiúnta 1986. Faoi na forálacha seo, agus bláin amháin á ghlaicadhe le bláin eile, dálítear mar dhuaiseanna suim nach lú ná 40% den airgead iomlán a fuair an Comhlacht mar thoradh ar dhíolachán thicéid an Chranncuir Náisiúnta. Déantar soláthar do na duaiseanna de réir mar a aithnítear an t-ioncam ar bhonn cibé struchtúr duaise a bhíonn ag cluiche ar leith. Léirítear i measc na gCreidiúnaithe ar an gClár Comhardaithe cibé difríocht a bhíonn idir an tsuim iomlán a sholáthraitear agus na suimeanna a dháiltear.

4. Caiteachas ar Fhógraíocht is ar Chur Chun Cinn

Díscróbhtar iomlán an chaiteachais ar fhógraíocht is ar chur chun cinn sa bhliain ina tharraingítear na costais.

5. Sócmhainní ar léasanna oibriúcháin

Geartar costas chíosanna ar léasanna oibriúcháin ar an gCuntas Brabús agus Caillteanais ar bhonn mhéid chothroim thréimhse an léasa.

6. Cánochas

Tá díolúine ag an gComhlacht ó Cháin Chorparáide faoi Alt 220 den Acht Comhdhlúite Cánochá 1997.

7. Sócmhainní Seasta – Sócmhainní Inláimhsithe

Ní léirítear aon leabharluach a bheith ag sócmhainní inláimhsithe ón uair go n-aisíofátar a gcostas iomlán leis an gComhlacht as Ciste an Chranncuir Náisiúnta.

Dá réir, ní thagann aon mhuirear dímheasa i gceist.

I gcás na sócmhainní seo, feidhmíonn an Comhlacht mar iontaobháí thar ceann an Stáit, faoi Alt 17(1) (a) d'Acht um Chranncuir Náisiúnta 1986.

8. Sócmhainní Seasta – Sócmhainní Airgeadais

Léirítear sócmhainní seasta airgeadais ar luach a gcostas, lúide soláthar d'aon laghdú luacha. Tá aon ioncam a fhaightear ó shócmhainní seasta airgeadais le feiceáil sa chuntas brabús agus cailteanais sa bhliain ina fhaightear é.

9. Stoic

Áirítear mar stoic aon stoc ticéad scríobchártaí agus luacháiltear iad ar a gcostas. Áirítear sa chostas dieachtanna allmhairithe, CBL agus costais iompair. Díscróbhtar aon stoc atá as dáta nó nach féidir a úsáid.

Accounting Policies

Polasaithe Cuntasáiochta

10. Foreign Currencies

Transactions denominated in foreign currencies are translated into Euro and recorded at the rate of exchange ruling at the date of the transaction. Monetary liabilities denominated in foreign currencies are translated into Euro at the rate of exchange ruling at the balance sheet date or at forward purchase contract rates where such contracts exist. All exchange differences are dealt with in the Profit and Loss Account.

11. Pensions

Pensions are provided to seconded staff under multi-employer defined benefit superannuation schemes which are administered by the Company's parent, An Post, and a defined contribution scheme. In relation to the defined contribution scheme, contributions are accrued and recognised in operating profit or loss in the period in which they are earned by the relevant staff.

Due to the seconded nature of staff, the Company is unable to identify its share of the underlying assets and liabilities in the defined benefit scheme which may be attributable to the Company on a consistent and reasonable basis. Because of this, as permitted by FRS 17, the defined benefit schemes are accounted for by the Company as if the schemes were defined contribution schemes.

10. Airgeadra Coigríche

Aistrítear isteach in euro aon bheart, a chéad léiríodh in airgeadra coigríche, agus an ráta malaire, a bhí i bhfeidhm lá an bhirt, á úsáid. 11. Pinsin

16. Pensions

The pension entitlements of staff arise under a number of An Post externally funded defined benefit and defined contribution pension schemes, the assets of which are vested in independent trustees appointed by An Post for the sole benefit of employees and their dependants.

An Post operates multi-employer defined benefit schemes. Due to the seconded nature of staff the Company is unable to identify the share of the underlying assets and liabilities in the schemes, which may be attributable to the Company, on a consistent and reasonable basis. Because of this, as permitted by FRS17, the schemes have been accounted for by the Company as if the schemes were defined contribution schemes.

The valuations of the An Post defined benefit schemes used for the purposes of the FRS17 disclosures have been based on the previous actuarial valuations carried out at 1 January, 2008, updated by the independent actuaries in accordance with FRS17 to assess the schemes' liabilities at 31 December, 2008. The schemes' assets were stated at their market value at that date. The net pension liabilities of the pension schemes at 31 December, 2010, the most recently available information, amounted to €368 million. At that date An Post had 9,670 permanent employees not including the 103 staff of An Post National Lottery Company.

The pension costs of the An Post defined benefit schemes are assessed in accordance with the advice of an independent professionally qualified actuary. The most recent actuarial valuations were carried out at 1 January, 2008, using the attained age method and disclosed that the assets of the schemes at that date were sufficient to cover more than 100% of the accrued liabilities after allowing for expected future increases in pensionable remuneration.

Contributions to the defined benefit schemes were at a rate of 14.4% (2010: 14.4%) of pensionable remuneration.

An amount of €18,000 is included in accruals (2010: €14,000) representing contributions payable to An Post with respect to the pension schemes at 31 December, 2011.

19. Group Membership and Controlling Party

The Company is a subsidiary undertaking of An Post which holds 80% of the issued share capital.

The sole activity of the Company is the operation of the National Lottery under Licence from the Minister for Public Expenditure and Reform in accordance with the provisions of the National Lottery Act, 1986. The Licence expires on 30 June, 2013. The surplus generated each year is entirely attributable to the National Lottery Fund and, accordingly, the results of the Company are not consolidated within the An Post Group.

The Company was managed and controlled throughout the year by the Directors on behalf of An Post and the ultimate controlling party, the Minister for Public Expenditure and Reform.

20. Related Party Disclosures

In addition to the secondment of staff working in the Company, undertakings in the An Post Group provide the Company with management and delivery of services. Such services are carried out on an arm's length basis or, where appropriate, in accordance with the terms of the Licence granted by the Minister for Public Expenditure and Reform to the Company, to operate the National Lottery. An Post also provides agency services to the Company whereby An Post makes sales and pays prizes on behalf of the Company in accordance with the standard terms and conditions and remuneration structure common to all of the Company's agents.

Excluding staff costs (Note 6) and including the Management Fee, expenses for the year in respect of services provided by An Post Group undertakings to the Company amounted to €5,859,000 (2010: €6,172,000).

Amounts due to An Post are set out in Note 12 of the accounts.

The Company's parent, An Post, has agreed to guarantee the performance by the Company of its obligations under the Licence for the holding of the National Lottery granted by the Minister for Public Expenditure and Reform. An Post has provided the guarantee, the maximum liability of which amounts to €10 million, for the duration of the Licence.

21. Board Approval

The financial statements were approved by the Board of Directors on 21 February, 2012.
