Over €14 billion in Sales

Over the 28 years since it was established, the National Lottery has steadily increased its turnover. From sales of €130 million in its first nine months, accumulated sales now stand at €14.1 billion.

Over €7 billion in Prizes

National Lottery players have reaped the benefits of playing. From 1987 to 2014, over €7.4 billion in prize money has been won by millions of players.

€4.5 billion raised for Good Causes

Over the last 28 years, €4.5 billion has been raised by the National Lottery, and distributed by Government, to benefit good causes all over Ireland.

Chairman's statement

2014 was a significant year in the development of Ireland's National Lottery. In February 2014, Premier Lotteries Ireland Limited (PLI), signed a twenty year licence to operate the National Lottery from 30th November 2014. The staff and management of the previous operator, An Post National Lottery Company, including CEO Dermot Griffin, transferred to PLI, ensuring continuity of operations. An Post successfully operated the Irish National Lottery since its creation in 1986 and I am pleased to report will continue as one of the shareholders of PLI. Premier Lotteries Ireland Limited commenced operations on 30th November 2014 and this Annual Report reflects the last trading period up to 29th November 2014 for the An Post National Lottery Company as the operator of the National Lottery.

The shareholders of PLI are Ontario Teachers' Pension Plan (OTPP), An Post and An Post Pension Funds. OTPP has a successful track record in the lottery industry through its shareholdings in the Camelot Group, which includes UK National Lottery operator Camelot UK Lotteries Limited.

Premier Lotteries Ireland Limited represents the best in lottery expertise globally and is uniquely positioned to grow the Irish National Lottery over the coming 20 years for the benefit of good causes.

Ráiteas an Chathaoirligh

Bliain shuntasach ba ea 2014 i bhforbairt Chrannchuir Náisiúnta na hÉireann. Mí Feabhra 2014 shínigh Phríomh-Chrannchuir Éireann Teoranta (PCÉ) ceadúnas fiche bliain chun an Crannchuir Náisiúnta a reáchtáil ó 30 Samhain 2014. D'aistrigh an fhoireann is an bhainistíocht ón oibritheoir a bhí cheana, Comhlacht Chrannchuir Náisiúnta an Phoist, an príomhfheidhmeannach, Dermot Griffin san áireamh, go dtí PCÉ, rud a chinntigh leanúnachas sa tseirbhís. Tá breis is 50 bliain de thaithí bainistíochta i mbainistiú Chrannchuir Náisiúnta na hÉireann nuasaithe ag an bhfoireann bainistíochta. Reáchtáil An Post Crannchuir Náisiúnta na hÉireann ó bunaíodh é i 1986. Chuaigh Príomh-Chrannchuir Éireann Teoranta i mbun oibre ar 30 Samhain 2014 tar éis dóibh os cionn 20,000 píosa trealamh a shuiteáil go sásúil ina líonra miondíola de 3,700 gníomhaire ar fud na hÉireann.

Is iad Ontario Teachers' Pension Plan (OTPP), An Post agus Cistí Pinsin an Phoist scairshealbhóirí PCÉ. Tá cuntas teiste an-rathúil i ngnó chrannchuir ag OTPP trína chuid scairshealbhe le Grúpa Camelot a chuimsíonn oibritheoir Crannchuir Náisiúnta na RA, Camelot UK Lotteries Limited.

Tá scoth na saintaithí ag Príomh-Chrannchuir Éireann Teoranta ar shaineolas ar chrannchuir ar fud an domhain agus tá cumas ar leith ann chun Crannchuir Náisiúnta na hÉireann a fhás sna fiche bliain atá romhainn amach ar mhaithe le dea-chúiseanna.

2014 Performance

I'm pleased to report that, although the retail market continued to be challenging in 2014, a further €178.9 million or 28.4% of sales was raised for good causes in the 11 months to 29 November 2014. Since the establishment of the National Lottery 28 years ago, a cumulative total of €4.5 billion has been generated from National Lottery sales for distribution by the Government to good causes and communities throughout Ireland.

The high rate of player participation continued during the year with 44% of all adults playing one or more National Lottery games on a regular basis. Players, between them, shared prizes to the value of €355.1 million in 2014, representing 56.3% of sales, an increase from 55.9% of sales in 2013.

Our sales for the eleven month period to November were €630.9m, which when annualised represents a 0.4% increase on 2013 full year sales of €685.2m.

Operations

We successfully reduced total operating costs during 2014 to €87.4 million which represents 13.9% of sales, compared to 14.1% in 2013.

I would like to thank the National Lottery management team and all employees for their professionalism and continued commitment to the successful operation of Ireland's National Lottery and, in particular, for their assistance with the transition to Premier Lotteries Ireland Limited (PLI) as the new operator.

Feidhmíocht 2014

Is áthas liom a thuairisciú, in ainneoin an margadh miondíola a bheith fós dúshlánach i 2014, gur tuilleadh €178.9 milliún breise nó 28.4% den díolachán do dhea-chúiseanna. Ó bunaíodh an Crannchur Náisiúnta 28 mbliain ó shin, gineadh iomlán carnaithe de €4.5 billiún ó dhíolachán an Chrannchuir Náisiúnta le dáileadh ag an Rialtas ar dhea-chúiseanna is ar phobail ar fud na hÉireann.

Lean an leibhéal ard rannpháirtíochta ag imreoirí le linn na bliana agus d'imir 44% de dhaoine fásta ceann amháin nó níos mó de chluichí an Chrannchuir Náisiúnta ar bhonn rialta. Roinneadh duaiseanna dar luach €355.1 milliún ar imreoirí. B'ionann é seo agus 56.3% den díolachán, ardú ó 55.9% i 2013.

Bhí díolachán againn don tréimhse naoi mí go dtí Samhain de €630.9m. Nuair a dhéantar bliantúil air seo is ionann é agus méadú de 0.4% ar dhíolachán 2013, arbh ionann é agus €685.2m.

Oibríochtaí

D'éirigh linn na costais iomlána oibriúcháin a laghdú le linn 2014 go dtí €87.4 milliún, arb ionann é agus 13.9% den díolachán, i gcomparáid le 14.1% i 2013.

Ba mhaith liom buíochas a ghabháil le foireann bainistíochta an Chrannchuir Náisiúnta agus leis na fostaithe uile as a ngairmiúlacht agus as a dtiomantas leanúnach do réachtáil rathúil Chrannchur Náisiúnta na hÉireann, agus go rí-speisialta, as a gcúnamh leis an trasdul chuig Príomh-Chrannchuir Éireann Teoranta, mar oibritheoir.

As chairman, I would also like to thank my fellow board members for their valued support and advice in what was a significant year for the organisation. The continued support provided by our shareholders, the Minister for Public Expenditure and Reform, who was also our Regulator up to 16 November 2014, and An Post, was much appreciated.

We look forward to continuing our involvement in the National Lottery through PLI as we work to develop and grow Ireland's National Lottery raising further funds for good causes.

Review of Operations

A total of €178.9 million in funds was generated for good causes during 2014, despite the continued challenging retail environment and the shortened sales period to 29th November 2014.

Another highlight for the year is that our online games channel continued to grow in 2014.

Sales of €11.3 million in 2013 increased significantly to €16.2 million by the end of November 2014.

Also worth noting was the high profile and high value EuroMillions jackpot wins by players in Ireland, making us one of the luckiest countries participating in this game.

Overall sales for 2014 were €630.9 million for the 11 months sales period, which represents close to €200 for each adult in the country.

Players

Ireland's participation rate in National Lottery games is 44% of all adults playing on a regular basis.

2014 was a good year for our players who were rewarded with prizes to the value of €355.1 million or 56.3% of sales.

Athbhreithniú Oibríochtaí

Gineadh ciste iomlán de €178.9 milliún do dhea-chúiseanna le linn 2014, in ainneoin an timpeallacht miondíola a bheith dúshlánach. Buaicphointe eile sa bhliain ba ea gur lean ár gcainéal do chluichí ar líne de bheith ag fás le linn 2014. Tháinig méadú suntasach ar an ndíolachán de €11.3 milliún ag deireadh 2013 go dtí €16.2 milliún faoi dheireadh mhí na Samhna 2014. Is fiú suntas a thabhairt chomh maith do bhuanna phota óir Euromillions ag imreoirí in Éirinn, buanna a raibh próifíl agus luach ard ag baint leo, rud a fhágann go bhfuilimid ar cheann de na tíortha is ámharaí a ghlacann páirt sa chluiche.

Bhí díolachán iomlán de €630.9 milliún ann i 2014, figiúr arb ionann é agus €200 ag gach duine fásta sa tír.

Imreoirí

Tá ráta rannpháirtíochta na hÉireann ar ceann de na rátaí is airde ar domhan le 44% de na daoine fásta uile ag imirt ar bhonn rialta. Bliain sár-mhaith d'ár n-imreoirí ba ea 2014 agus bronnadh luach €355.1 milliún de dhuaiseanna orthu nó 56.3% den díolachán.

During the course of the year players in Ireland also won big EuroMillions prizes:

- A Limerick man won €105,000 in the EuroMillions draw in August 2014.
- In September 2014, a syndicate from Ballybrack in Dublin won €87 million in the EuroMillions draw.
- In November, a €6 Quick Pick ticket bought in Tralee secured €500,000 for the lucky ticket owner in the EuroMillions draw.

The total won by EuroMillions players in Ireland since the game launched here in 2004 now stands at €568.9 million.

Lotto

Lotto games represent the largest category in the National Lottery business. As a percentage of overall sales, Lotto sales account for a significant 31.9% while the Lotto family of games including Lotto Plus and Lotto 5-4-3-2-1 games account for 43.1% of overall sales, compared to 45.3% in 2013.

During 2014, Lotto sales were €201 million, compared to €229.5 million in 2013. This represents a 4% decrease on annualised sales over 2013. Overall the level of jackpots was higher than the previous year, with the highest jackpot of the year at €12.1 million, compared to €10.6 million in 2013.

In 2014, the average Lotto jackpot value was just over €4.3 million, 7% above the average value in the previous year.

Is é €568.9 milliún an tsuim iomlán a bhuaigh imreoirí Euromillions in Éirinn ó seoladh an cluiche anseo i 2004.

Lotto

Is iad na cluichí Lotto an catagóir cluichí is mó i ngnó an Chrannchuir Náisiúnta. Mar chéatadán den díolachán iomlán is ionann díolachán Lotto agus 31.9%, figiúr suntasach, agus is ionann an fine iomlán cluichí Lotto, Lotto Plus agus Lotto 5-4-3-2-1 san áireamh, 43.1% den díolachán iomlán i gcomparáid le 45.3% i 2013.

Le linn 2014, bhí €201 milliún de dhíolachán ar Lotto ann i gcomparáid le €229.5 milliún i 2013. Is ionann é seo agus laghdú 4% ar dhíolachán 2013 nuair a dhéantar bliantúlú air. Tríd is tríd bhí leibhéal na bpotáí óir níos airde ná an bhliain roimhe. Bé €12.1 milliún an pota óir ba mhó i gcomparáid le €10.6 milliún i 2013.

There was one jackpot win worth over €10 million during the year, two jackpot wins of over €8 million and three jackpot wins of over €5 million. Lotto players shared a total of €104.5 million in prizes and 15 new millionaires were created.

In June, a Lotto jackpot of €12,155,282 was won by a syndicate from Donegal. The winning ticket was sold in American House, Bundoran, Co. Donegal.

Lotto Plus

The performance of the Lotto Plus game closely reflects that of Lotto with 91.4% of Lotto players also playing Lotto Plus. Lotto Plus sales were €59.8 million in the eleven months under review. Lotto Plus players shared €28.5 million in prizes, with 34 top prize winners.

Lotto 5-4-3-2-1

Lotto 5-4-3-2-1, remained a favourite with those players looking for higher odds of winning amounts from €4 to €100,000. Sales of €11.3 million were generated in 2014, compared to €13 million for 12 months in 2013. This represents a 5.3% decline when proportionately adjusted. Lotto 5-4-3-2-1 players won a total of €7.5 million in prizes, with a high prize pay-out of 66.8%.

EuroMillions

EuroMillions sales were €119 million, an increase of 10.2%, when adjusted, on 2013 sales.

We offered two guaranteed Jackpots of €100 million which generated €22.1 million in sales.

Mí an Mheithimh bhuaigh sindeacáit gan ainm ó Dhún na nGall pota óir Lotto de €12,155,282. Díoladh ticéad an bhua san American House, Bun Dobhráin, Co. Dhún na nGall.

Lotto Plus

Is cosúil go maith feidhmiúchán an chluiche Lotto Plus le ceann Lotto agus 91.4% d'imreoirí Lotto ag imirt Lotto Plus chomh maith. B'ionann díolachán Lotto Plus agus €59.8 milliún sa tréimhse aon mhí déag atá faoi chaibidil. Is ionann e seo agus laghdú 3.2% i gcomparáid le feidhmiúchán 2013. Roinneadh duaiseanna dar luach €28.5 milliún ar imreoirí Lotto Plus agus bhain 34 buaiteoir barr-dhuaiseanna.

Lotto 5-4-3-2-1

Lean Lotto 5-4-3-2-1 de bheith ina rogha ag na himreoirí úd a lorgaíonn corrlach níos fearr suimeanna ó €4 go 100,000 a bhuachan. Gineadh díolachán de €11.3 milliún i 2014 i gcomparáid le €13 milliún sa tréimhse 12 mí i 2013. Is ionann é seo agus laghdú de 5.3% nuair a dhéantar coigeartú coibhneasach. Bhuaigh imreoirí Lotto 5-4-3-2-1 iomlán de €7.5 milliún de dhuaiseanna le híocaíocht ard duaiseanna de 66.8%.

EuroMillions players in Ireland did well in 2014 with almost 100,000 players winning cash prizes each week.

EuroMillions Plus

Sales of EuroMillions Plus were up, from €40.7 million in 2013 to €41.7 million. 70.1% of EuroMillions players also played the Plus game, compared to 69.1% in 2013.

During the year EuroMillions Plus players shared €22.6 million in prizes, with 16 top prize winners of €500,000.

Scratch Card Games

The All Cash group of games was the most popular Scratch Card game category in 2014 with sales of €90 million while the biggest seller in terms of unit sales was All Cash €1 scratch cards which sold 23.6 million tickets. The launch of a new €20 All Cash game, our first ever €20 ticket, proved very popular with players, delivering €5 million in sales.

The prize fund for Scratch Card games was €109.9 million in 2014, from €111.1 million in 2013 but this represented an 8% uplift when adjusted on a proportional basis for the eleven month sales period.

Overall, sales of Scratch Cards, including online Instant Win Games, decreased by 2% from €167.7 million in 2013 to €164.2 million but this represented a 7% uplift when adjusted for 11 month sales period.

EuroMillions

Bhí díolachán de €119 milliún ar Euromillions – méadú de 10.2% ar dhíolachán 2013 é seo nuair a dhéantar oiriúnú.

Rinneamar dhá phota óir, le barántas de €100 milliún a thairiscint agus ghin siad €22.1 (milliún)? de dhíolachán.

Rinne imreoirí Euromillions in Éirinn go maith i 2014 agus bhuaigh díreach faoi bhun 100,000 imreoir duaiseanna airgid gach seachtain.

EuroMillions Plus

Bhí méadú ar dhíolachán Euromillions Plus ó €40.7 milliún i 2013 go dtí €41.7 milliún. D'imir 78.3% d'imreoirí Euromillions an cluiche Plus chomh maith i gcomparáid le 77% i 2013.

Le linn na bliana roinneadh luach €22.6 milliún de dhuaiseanna ar imreoirí Euromillions Plus agus bhí 13 buaiteoir barr-dhuaise de €500,000 ann.

Cluichí Scríobcháarta

Bhí fine All Cash ar an gcatagóir de chluichí Scríobcháarta ba mhó éilimh i 2014 le díolachán de €90 milliún agus i dtéarmaí líon na n-aonad a díoladh b'iad scríobcháartaí €1 All Cash a b'fhearr a dhíol. Díoladh 23.6 milliún ticéad. Bhí an-tóir ar sheoladh an chluiche nua All Cash ar €20 agus baineadh amach díolachán de €5 milliún.

TV Game Shows

The National Lottery launched a brand new Grand Prize Game format in 2014 hosted by Brian Ormond. The Money Spinner saw Brian bring the Lottery Wheel to locations around Ireland, with a total prize fund of €4 million. The show was broadcast from Dublin as well as travelling to counties Kilkenny, Mayo, Westmeath, Donegal, Clare and Cavan. Every week each of the five players had the chance to win €250,000 on the wheel, while there were also additional feature prizes to be won. The Money Spinner Game was live streamed on the lottery.ie website. The series generated sales of €8.9 million.

Winning Streak, broadcast on RTÉ and hosted by Marty Whelan and Sinead Kennedy, was watched by approximately 250,000 viewers each week and generated sales of €28.2 million. A total prize fund of €9.8 million was won by 234 players.

Millionaire Raffle

The National Lottery ran a limited edition Millionaire Raffle Draw during Easter 2014 generating €3.2 million in sales.

The €1 million Easter Millionaire Raffle prize was claimed by an anonymous winner from Co. Dublin who bought their ticket in Kenny's Centra, Lower Kimmage Road Dublin 6.

A Millionaire Raffle €250,000 winning ticket was sold in Ard Brae Service Station, Vevay Road, Bray, Co. Wicklow.

Bhí duaischiste de €109.9 milliún ann do chluichí Scríobchartaí i 2014 i gcomparáid le €111.1 milliún i 2013 ach b'ionann é seo agus ardú de 8% nuair a dhéantar coigeartú coibhneasach don tréimhse díolacháin aon mhí deag.

Ar an bhforiomlán bhí laghdú imeallach ar dhíolachán Scríobchartaí, ar a n-áirítear na cluichí Tob-bhua ar líne, ó €167.7 milliún i 2013 go dtí €164.2 milliún ach b'ionann é seo agus méadú 7% nuair a dhéantar an coigeartú.

Seochluichí Teilifíse

Sheol an Crannchur Náisiúnta seochluiche teilifíse úrnua i 2014 agus é á chur i láthair ag Brian Ormond. Leis an Money Spinner thóg Brian Roth an Lotto ar fud na hÉireann le duaischiste de bhreis is €4 milliún. Craoladh an clár ó Bhaile Átha Cliath agus thaisteal sé chomh maith go dtí contaetha Cill Chainnigh, Maigh Eo, an Iarmhí, Dún na nGall, an Clár agus Cabhán. Gach seachtain bhí deis ag gach duine den cúigear imreoir €250,000 a bhuachan ar an roth agus bhí duaiseanna ar leith breise ann freisin le buachan. Rinneadh an Seochluiche Money Spinner a shruthú beo ar shuíomh gréasáin lottery.ie. Ghin an tsraith seo díolachán de €8.9 milliún.

Craoladh Winning Streak ar RTÉ agus Marty Whelan agus Sinead Kennedy mar óstaigh air. Bhí lucht féachana de thart faoi 250,000 aige gach seachtain agus ghin sé díolachán de €28.2 milliún. Bhuaigh 234 imreoir duaischiste iomlán de €9.8 milliún.

Millionaire Raffle

Reáchtáil an Crannchur Náisiúnta eagrán ar leith de Chrannchur Millionaire Raffle le linn na Cásca i 2014 agus ghin sé díolachán de €3.2 milliún.

TellyBingo

A total of €12.4 million was won in prizes on Tellybingo. There were three promotions (Valentine's Day; 8th May and 11th September) in the TellyBingo game during 2014. Sales of TellyBingo in 2014 were €15.9 million compared to €17.1 million in 2013, representing a 1.3% uplift for the eleven month period.

Daily Million

Sales of Daily Million and Daily Million Plus amounted to €14.8 million in 2014. Sales of the game were particularly strong online.

Play Online

During 2014 online play continued to be the fastest growing area of National Lottery business. Modifications made to the registration process in April 2014 allowed us to increase registration numbers from 57,000 to 134,000 by the end of November 2014. Sales of €11.3 million at the end of 2013 increased to €16.2 million by the end of November 2014, an increase of 60%. Instant win games performed particularly well representing 14.6% of play online sales.

The biggest online winners of the year were two winners of €350,000 each and one winner of €250,000 won by players from Dublin and Meath.

TellyBingo

Buadh iomlán de €12.4 milliún mar dhuaiseanna ar Tellybingo. Bhí trí phromóisean i gcluiche TellyBingo le linn 2014 – (ar Lá San Valentín, 14 Feabhra, ar 8 Bealtaine agus ar 11 Meán Fómhair). Imir ar Líne

Le linn 2014 b'í imirt ar líne an ghné ba thapúla fáis i ngnó an Chrannchuir Náisiúnta. Feabhsuithe sa mhodh clárúcháin ba chúis le méadú sa líon daoine a bhí ag clárú ó 40,000 go dtí 134,000 faoi dheireadh mhí na Samhna 2014. Bhí méadú ar an díolachán ó €11.3 milliún ag deireadh 2013 go dtí €16.2 milliún faoi dheireadh mhí na Samhna 2014. Bhí an-ráchairt ar chluichí tob-bhua. B'ionann a ndíolachán agus 14.6% den díolachán iomlán ar líne.

B'iad na buaiteoirí ba mhó ar líne le linn na bliana ná beirt bhuaiteoir de €350,000 an duine agus buaiteoir amháin de dhuais de €250,000. Imreoirí as Baile Átha Cliath agus ón Mhí a bhain na duaiseanna.

Operations

In 2014, National Lottery staff managed a total of 1,456 draws, with 31 draws now taking place every week. Total operating expenses for the year were €87.4 million, representing 13.9% of sales compared to 14.1% in 2013. The largest of these expenses was agents' commission which at €38.6 million represented 6.1% of total sales.

Administrative costs for 2014 were €16.7 million and equate to 2.6% of sales, compared to 2.7% in 2013.

The number of retail agents was 3,700 in 2014. Large digital display screens in retail agents have proven to be an effective means of communicating real-time jackpot details and other National Lottery game information directly to our players at the point of purchase. We also continued to invest in developing our website and the annual number of visits was over 24 million in 2014. The trend towards mobile access via mobile phone and tablets to our website continued upwards during the year from 44% in 2013 to 60% in 2014.

Our Facebook community continued to grow, reaching over 140,000 fans by the end of November 2014.

Two of our marketing campaigns won awards during 2014. Our Daily Million advertising campaign (One Million, one Euro, everyday) won an Advertising Effectiveness 'Gold' award at the Institute of Advertising Practitioners in Ireland (IAPI), ADFX 2014 awards. Also, our play online marketing campaign featuring the National Lottery guru, won the Best Advertising Campaign award at the All Ireland Marketing Awards 2014.

Corporate Responsibility

Promoting responsible gaming is a core value of the National Lottery and remains the cornerstone of the National Lottery's approach to Corporate Responsibility. Our aim is to provide exciting and engaging lottery games that bring fun and entertainment to players.

We work to ensure as far as possible that our games do not encourage excessive or underage play, that individuals play within their means and that the vulnerable and persons less than 18 years of age are protected. The Terms and Conditions and Prize Rules also specify that prizes will not be paid out to a minor. Our commitment to the highest standards of responsible gaming continues to be recognised at European and international level. Following a successful recertification audit in May 2014 carried out by Deloitte's, we continue to be aligned with European Lotteries Responsible Gaming Standards and World Lottery Association Responsible Gaming Framework.

Good causes

The National Lottery's mission is to operate a world class lottery raising funds for good causes on behalf of the Government and we are proud to have delivered on this objective again in 2014, raising a further €178.9 million for good causes. Since the National Lottery was launched in 1987, over €4.5 billion has been raised with over 32.1% of all National Lottery sales funding good causes around the country.

These funds have made a significant difference to communities, projects and individuals in the areas of youth, sports, recreation, amenities, health, welfare, arts, culture, national heritage and the Irish language. During

2014, we continued to highlight the level and positive impact of funds raised by featuring beneficiary projects on TV Game Shows, in The Spark (our good causes newsletter) and on the National Lottery website.

Premier Lotteries Ireland Limited took over the operation of the National Lottery in 2014 and this new licence provided an additional €405 million for the Government with around half of this money going towards the much needed National Children's Hospital and the remainder to other job-rich projects including the Wild Atlantic Way, the 1916 Commemoration and the National Sports Campus.

Some of the Good Causes funded by the National Lottery in 2014:

Autism Assistance Dogs Ireland (AADI) is a national charity providing highly trained assistance dogs for children with autism and their families. The dogs are specially trained to provide safety, independence and companionship to children who would otherwise live in a very isolated world. It takes nearly two years and €15,000 to train each dog most of which comes from public donations. AADI have placed 19 assistance dogs and 16 companion dogs. AADI have been overwhelmed by the demand for the dogs and currently have a six year waiting list which they have had to close. Autism Assistance Dogs Ireland was assisted by National Lottery funding in 2014.

Holly's Horse Haven is the only official cross border / cross community, 24/7 critical care rescue charity in Ireland. They are an endorsed, not-for-profit charity who make a meaningful difference in the lives of neglected and at-risk horses and ponies throughout the country through direct intervention, education, community outreach, the raising of awareness, and through hands-on horse rescue, rehabilitation and re-homing.

Horse rescues are integrated into an equine therapy/training programme, a relatively new type of rehab therapy which teaches youth, disabled and troubled individuals how to care for and be responsible for others.

The combination of working with the animal and caring for another being enables the individual to grow emotionally, mentally and physically. Equine therapy has been found to be extremely effective for treating mental health problems, encouraging youth assertiveness, disability support and addictions. Holly's Horse Haven was assisted by National Lottery funding in 2014.

Mid-West Simon Community is part of the Federation of Simon Communities which provide the best possible care, accommodation and support for people experiencing homelessness and those at risk. Together with people who are homeless, Simon tackles the root causes and promotes innovative responses. Simon delivers support and service to between 4,500 and 5,000 individuals and families who experience - or are at risk of - homelessness on an annual basis.

National Lottery Good Causes funding supported the purchase of equipment necessary to set up a Food Bank Service in three locations operated by the Mid-West Simon Community.

National Governing Body for Sailing and Motor Boating in Ireland (ISA)

Annalise Murphy, who came fourth in the 2012 London Olympic Games, is a member of the Irish Sailing Association's Performance Department and is currently in training for the 2016 Rio Olympic Games. Annalise's training is funded by the Sports Council which receives National Lottery funds, making the

The Directors have pleasure in submitting their twenty eight annual report, together with the audited financial statements of the Company, for the year ended 31 December 2014, in fulfilment of their obligations under the Companies Act 2014.

1. The Company

The principal activity of the Company during the year was operating the National Lottery under Licence from the Minister for Public Expenditure and Reform in accordance with the provisions of the National Lottery Act, 1986.

80% of the issued share capital is held by An Post and 20% is held by the Minister for Public Expenditure and Reform.

2. Results for the Year

The results for the year are set out on page 39.

3. Business Review

In October 2013, the Minister for Public Expenditure and Reform announced that Premier Lotteries Ireland Limited had been selected as the preferred bidder for the next National Lottery Licence which will be in place for a 20 year period. The new licence was signed on 27 February 2014 following which Premier Lotteries Ireland Limited entered a transition phase to take over operating the National Lottery from the Company. This transition was completed on 29th November, 2014 and the Company ceased trading on that date. Therefore, the results for the year reflect 11 months trading.

During the year, the Company generated sales of €631m (2013: €685m). After prizes and operating costs including costs associated with the transfer of the licence and expected costs of winding up the company, this resulted in a surplus of €179m to the benefit of the Beneficiary Fund.

Síníodh an ceadúnas nua ar 27 Feabhra 2014 agus ansin thosaigh Príomh-Chrannchuir Éireann Teoranta céim trasdula chun reáchtáil An Chrannchuir Náisiúnta a ghlacadh ar lámha ón gComhlacht. 4. Directors, Secretary and their interests

The Directors of the Company are appointed by the Minister for Public Expenditure and Reform and their conditions of appointment and fees are set out in writing.

On 22 July 2014, Mr. Jack Dempsey retired as Company Secretary and Mr. Brian Fay was appointed on the same date.

The Directors and Secretary who held office at 31 December, 2014 had no interest in the shares in, or debentures of, the Company or any Group Company.

5. Employees

As part of the transition to the new operator, some staff in the Company availed of a voluntary severance/early retirement scheme and the remaining staff transferred to Premier Lotteries Ireland Limited on 30 November 2014 under the Transfer of Undertakings Protection legislation.

6. Corporate Governance

Maintaining high standards of corporate governance continued to be a priority of the Directors of the Company in 2014. The Board has developed its corporate governance policy so as to give effect to the Code of Practice for the Governance of State Bodies issued by the Department of Finance and to apply the principles of good governance as appropriate to such an enterprise.

The Directors are accountable to the shareholders for good corporate governance and this report addresses how the relevant main and supporting principles of the Code of Best Practice for the Governance of State Bodies have been applied within the Company.

The Board

The Company is controlled through its Board of Directors. Up to the date of cessation of the Licence, the Board's main roles were to oversee the operation of the Company, to provide leadership to the Company, to approve the Company's strategic objectives and to ensure that the necessary financial and other resources are made available to enable them to meet those objectives. The Board, which met monthly during the year, had a schedule of matters reserved for its approval.

The specific responsibilities reserved to the Board during the year included: setting Company strategy and approving an annual budget; reviewing operational and financial performance; approving major capital expenditure; ensuring compliance with the terms of the licence to operate the National Lottery, reviewing the Company's systems of financial control and risk management; ensuring that appropriate management development and succession plans were in place; reviewing the environmental, health and safety performance of the Company; approving the appointment of the Company Secretary; and ensuring that a satisfactory dialogue took place with shareholders.

The Board delegated the following responsibilities to management: implementation of the strategies and policies of the Company as determined by the Board; monitoring of the operating and financial results against plans and budgets; development of controls over the operation of draws, prioritising the allocation of technical and human resources; and developing and implementing risk management systems.

The roles of the Chairman and Chief Executive

The Chairman is responsible for organising the business of the Board, ensuring its effectiveness and setting its agenda. The Chairman facilitates the effective contribution of non-executive Directors and constructive relations between the executive Director and non-executive Directors, ensures that Directors receive accurate, timely and clear information and manages effective communication with shareholders.

Éascaíonn an Cathaoirleach rannpháirtíocht éifeachtach na Stiúrthóirí neamh-fheidhmiúcháin agus deachaidreamh idir iad agus an Stiúrthóir feidhmiúcháin agus cinntiú sé go bhfaigheann na Stiúrthóirí eolas cruinn, tráthúil agus soiléir.

The Chief Executive had direct charge of the Company on a day to day basis and was accountable to the Board for the financial and operational performance of the Company.

Directors and Directors' independence

Up to the date of cessation of the Licence, the Board comprised the Chairman, five non-executive Directors and the Chief Executive. The positions of Chairman and Chief Executive were held by different persons. The Board included independent non-executive Directors who brought strong, independent judgement, knowledge, and experience to the Board's deliberations. The composition of the board has remained unchanged since the cessation of the licence.

The National Lottery Act, 1986, prescribed that the number of directors of the Company be seven. The authority regarding selection, nomination and appointment of the Directors was directly vested with the Company's shareholders. As such considerations such as board composition, board appointments and board renewal rested with the Company's shareholders rather than with the Board.

The Chairman held meetings with the non-executive Directors without the executive Director being present. The Board had formal procedures in place in this regard.

Directors have the right to ensure that any concerns they have, which cannot be resolved, about the running of the Company or a proposed action, are recorded in the Board minutes. In addition, upon resignation, a non-executive Director will be asked to provide a written statement to the Chairman, for circulation to the Board, if they have any such concerns.

The Directors are given access to independent professional advice at the Company's expense, when the Directors deem it is necessary in order for them to carry out their responsibilities.

The Company Secretary

The Company Secretary is a full time employee of the Company's parent company, An Post. The Company Secretary is responsible for advising the Board, through the Chairman, on all governance matters. All Directors have access to the advice and services of the Company Secretary. The Company's Articles of Association provide that the appointment and removal of the Company Secretary is a matter for the full Board.

Information

Regular reports and papers are circulated to the Directors in a timely manner in preparation for Board and Committee meetings. These papers are supplemented by information specifically requested by the Directors from time to time.

During the year, the non-executive Directors received monthly management accounts and regular management reports and information which enabled them to scrutinise the Company's and management's performance against agreed objectives.

Relations with shareholders

The Board and management maintain an ongoing dialogue with the Company's shareholders on strategic issues. In addition, under the National Lottery Act, 1986, certain operational matters require the approval of the Minister for Public Expenditure and Reform in respect of which ongoing contact with the Minister is maintained.

The Chairman gives feedback to the Board on issues raised with him by the shareholders. All Directors normally attend the Annual General Meeting and shareholders are invited to ask questions during the meeting and to meet with Directors after the formal proceedings have ended.

Internal Control and Risk Management

During the year, an ongoing process existed for identifying, evaluating and managing the significant risks faced by the Company. This process was periodically reviewed by the Directors and was been in place throughout the accounting period.

The Directors are responsible for the Company's system of internal control, setting appropriate policies on internal control, seeking regular assurance that will enable them to satisfy themselves that the system is functioning effectively and ensuring that the system of internal control is effective in managing risks in the manner which it has approved. Such a system is designed to manage rather than eliminate business risks and can provide only reasonable rather than absolute assurance against material misstatement or loss.

During the year, the Directors continued to review the effectiveness of the Company's system of financial and non-financial controls, including operational and compliance controls, risk management and the Company's high level internal control arrangements.

Eolas

Caidreamh le Scairshealbhóirí

Bíonn idirphlé leanúnach idir an Bord is an bhainistíocht le scairshealbhóirí an Chomhlachta faoi nithe straitéiseacha. Tugann an Cathaoirleach aiseolas don Bhord ar cheisteanna a thógann na scairshealbhóirí leis. Is gnách leis na Stiúrthóirí uile freastal ar an gCruinniú Cinnbhliana agus tugtar cuireadh do na scairshealbhóirí ceisteanna a chur le linn an chruinnithe agus casadh ar na Stiúrthóirí nuair a bhíonn deireadh leis na himeachtaí foirmiúla.

Rialú Inmheánach agus Bainistíocht Rioscaí

Tá próiseas leanúnach ann chun na rioscaí suntasacha, a gcaitheann an Comhlacht aghaidh a thabhairt orthu, a aithint, a mheasúnú agus a bhainistiú. Athbhreithníonn na Stiúrthóirí é ó am go chéile agus bhí feidhm leo le linn na tréimhse cuntasaíochta.

Tá na Stiúrthóirí freagrach as córas rialaithe inmheánaigh an Chomhlachta. Ba chóir dóibh polasaithe cuí ar rialú inmheánach a shocrú, deimhniú a lorg go rialta a shásóidh iad go bhfuil an córas ag feidhmiú go héifeachtach agus ní mór dóibh a bheith sásta go bhfuil an córas rialaithe inmheánaigh éifeachtach chun rioscaí a bhainistiú ar an dóigh a faomhadh. Ceaptar córas mar seo chun rioscaí gnó a bhainistiú seachas fáil réidh leo agus ní thig leis ach barántas réasúnta, seachas barántas iomlán, a thabhairt in aghaidh aon mhíríteas ábhartha nó cailleanas.

Le linn na bliana lean na Stiúrthóirí de bheith ag athbhreithniú éifeacht chóras rialaithe airgeadais agus neamh-airgeadais an Chomhlachta, ina measc rialúchán oibríoch agus géilliúntais, bainistíocht rioscaí agus socruithe rialaithe ardleibhéil an Chomhlachta.

These reviews included an assessment of internal controls by management, management assurance of the maintenance of controls, reports from the internal auditor and reports from the external auditor on matters identified in the course of its statutory audit work.

The key procedures which the Directors established with a view to providing effective internal control during the year were as follows:

- A clear focus on business objectives as determined by the Board after consideration of the statutory responsibilities and risk profile of the Company's business.
- A defined organisational structure with clear lines of responsibility, delegation of authority and segregation of duties designed to foster a beneficial control environment.
- A risk management process which considered the strategy and development of the business in the context of the annual budget process when financial plans and performance targets were set and reviewed by the Board in light of the Company's overall objectives.
- A report and control system which produced a comprehensive set of financial reports. The annual budget was approved by the Board. Key financial statistics were monitored by management on a daily basis. Actual results were reported monthly against budget and any significant adverse variances examined and remedial action taken.
- Control procedures – comprehensive procedures manuals were maintained by the Company in respect of all its main activities. In particular, there were clearly defined limits and procedures for financial expenditure, including procurement and capital expenditure, and for all draw operations.
- Monitoring system – compliance with control objectives was monitored on an ongoing basis by management. The control system was also monitored by internal audit whose work was focused on the areas of greatest risk to the Company.

The Company had procedures to ensure that appropriate arrangements were in place for employees to be able to raise, in confidence, matters of possible impropriety, with suitable subsequent follow-up action. Reporting channels were in place whereby perceived wrongdoing may be reported orally and via post, telephone and email, anonymously if preferred.

The Audit & Risk Committee

During the year, the Audit & Risk Committee comprised of Micheál Ó Muircheartaigh, Caroline Murphy and Donal Connell. Micheál Ó Muircheartaigh acted as Chairperson of the Committee. All the members of the Committee were non-executive Directors.

Under its terms of reference, during the year, the Audit & Risk Committee continued to monitor the integrity of the Company's financial statements. The Committee is responsible for monitoring the effectiveness of the external audit process and making recommendations to the Board in relation to the appointment, re-appointment and remuneration of the external auditors. It is responsible for ensuring that an appropriate relationship between the Company and the external auditors is maintained, including reviewing non-audit services and fees. As a result of regulatory or similar requirements, it was necessary to employ the Company's external auditors for certain audit related and non-audit services. In order to maintain the independence of the external auditors, the Committee determined policies as to what audit related and non-audit services could be provided by the Company's external auditors and the approval process related to these services. In particular, the Board considered it appropriate that independent observer and draw related services, which were the principal constituent of non audit related fees paid, be performed by the external auditors. Under these policies, work of a consultancy nature was not offered to the external auditors unless there were clear efficiencies and value added benefits to the Company while ensuring that the objectivity and independence of the external auditors was maintained. The Committee monitored the level of fees paid to the external auditors.

During the year, the Committee reviewed the Company's systems of internal control and the processes for monitoring and evaluating the risks facing the Company.

The Committee met with management, as well as privately with the external auditors.

In 2014, the Committee discharged its responsibilities by:

- reviewing the Company's draft financial statements prior to Board approval and meeting and reviewing with the external auditors their reports thereon;
- reviewing the appropriateness of the Company's accounting policies and the basis of preparation of the Company's financial statements;
- reviewing the potential impact on the Company's financial statements of significant matters;

Compliance statement

The Board has developed its corporate governance policy so as to give effect to the Code of Practice for the Governance of State Bodies issued by the Department of Finance and to meet the appropriate standards of good governance for such an entity.

The Directors confirm that the Company has been in compliance with the Code of Practice for the Governance of State Bodies throughout the financial year under review.

Going Concern

In October 2013, the Minister for Public Expenditure and Reform announced that Premier Lotteries Ireland Limited had been selected as the preferred applicant of the next National Lottery Licence which will be in place for a 20 year period. The new licence was signed on 27 February 2014 and following a period of transition, on 30 November 2014, Premier Lotteries Ireland Limited commenced as operator of the National Lottery under its new licence. The Company ceased trading on 29th November, 2014. In light of these events, the Directors have considered the basis of accounting and have deemed it appropriate that the financial statements be prepared on a wind up basis of accounting to reflect the fact that the Company ceased to hold the National Lottery licence, which means that assets and liabilities are stated at their net recoverable or payable amounts and costs associated with the transition of the Licence to Premier Lotteries Ireland Limited are provided for.

The auditors KPMG, Chartered Accountants, will continue in office in accordance with Section 383(2) of the Companies Act 2014.



The Directors are responsible for keeping adequate accounting records which disclose with reasonable accuracy at any time the financial position of the Company and to enable them to ensure that the financial statements comply with the Companies Act 2014. They have general responsibility are also responsible for taking such steps as are reasonably open to them to safeguard the assets of the Company and to prevent and detect fraud and other irregularities.



As explained more fully in the Directors' Responsibilities Statement set out on page 34, the directors are responsible for the preparation of the financial statements and for being satisfied that they give a true and fair view and otherwise comply with the Companies Act 2014. Our responsibility is to audit and express an opinion on the financial statements in accordance with Irish law and International Standards on Auditing (UK and Ireland). Those standards require us to comply with the Financial Reporting Council's Ethical Standards for Auditors.

Faoin gCód Cleachtais um Rialachas Chomhlachtaí Stáit ("An Cód") tá dualgas orainn tuairisc a thabhairt daoibh mura bhfuil an ráiteas faoin gcóras inmheánach rialaithe airgeadais, a éilítear sa Chód, cuimsithe sa Ráiteas ar Rialachas Corparáide ar leathanaigh 25 go 33, ag teacht le géilliúntas an Chomhlachta i leith pharagraf 13.1 (iii) den Chód nó mura bhfuil sé ag teacht leis eolas atá againne mar thoradh ar ár n-obair ar na ráitis airgeadais agus tugaimid tuairisc air mura bhfuil sé.

Bunús ár dtuarascála, ár bhfreagrachtaí agus srianta atá i bhfeidhm

Mar atá mínithe ar shlí níos iomláine sa Ráiteas ar Fhreagrachtaí na Stiúrthóirí mar atá leagtha amach ar leathanach 34, tá na stiúrthóirí freagrach as ullmhú na ráiteas airgeadais agus as bheith sásta go dtugann siad léargas fíor agus cothrom agus go bhfuil siad ag teacht ar gach slí eile le hAcht na gCuideachtaí 2014. Tá mar fhreagracht orainn na ráitis airgeadais a iniúchadh agus tuairim a nochtadh orthu faoi réir dhlí na hÉireann agus na gCaighdeán Iniúcháireachta Idirnáisiúnta (RA agus Éire). Éilíonn na caighdeáin úd go mbeimis in oiriúint le Caighdeáin Eiticíúla d'Iniúcháirí de chuid na Comhairle um Thuairisciú Airgeadais.

An audit undertaken in accordance with ISAs (UK & Ireland) involves obtaining evidence about the amounts and disclosures in the financial statements sufficient to give reasonable assurance that the financial statements are free from material misstatement, whether caused by fraud or error. 



Notes to the Financial Statements

For the year ended 31 December, 2014

1. The Company

The Company is a limited liability company, incorporated under the Companies Acts, 1963 to 2013. Under the Postal and Telecommunications Services Act, 1983, the Company is entitled to omit the word “Limited” from its name.

2. Accounting Policies

The following accounting policies have been applied consistently in dealing with items which are considered material in relation to the Company’s financial statements.

a) Basis of Accounting

The financial statements are prepared under the historical cost convention in accordance with applicable law and Irish Generally Accepted Accounting Practice which includes compliance with the financial reporting standards of the Financial Reporting Council as promulgated by The Institute of Chartered Accountants in Ireland. In October 2013, the Department of Public Expenditure and Reform announced that Premier Lotteries Ireland Limited had been selected as the preferred applicant of the next National Lottery Licence which will be in place for a 20 year period. The new licence was signed on 27 February 2014 and following a period of transition, on 30 November 2014, Premier Lotteries Ireland Limited commenced as operator of the National Lottery under its new licence. The Company ceased trading on 29th November, 2014. In light of these events, the Directors have considered the basis of accounting and have deemed it appropriate that the financial statements be prepared on a wind up basis and reflect the fact that the company ceased to hold the National Lottery licence on that date, which means that assets and liabilities are stated at their net recoverable or payable amounts and costs associated with the transition of the Licence to Premier Lotteries Ireland Limited are provided for.

Nótaí ar na Ráitis Airgeadais

Don bhliain dar críoch 31 Nollaig, 2014

1. An Comhlacht

Cuideachta faoi theorainn ráthaíochta é an Comhlacht, atá corpraithe faoi Achtanna na gCuideachtaí, 1963 chuig 2013. Faoin Acht Seirbhísí Poist agus Teileachumarsáide, 1983, tá an Comhlacht i dteideal an focal “Teoranta” a fhágáil ar lár as a ainm.

2. Polasaithe Cuntasaíochta

Leanadh na polasaithe cuntasaíochta seo a leanas go seasta agus míreanna, a mheastar a bheith ábhartha i dtaca le ráitis airgeadais an Chomhlachta, á láimhseáil.

a) Bunús na Cuntasaíochta

Ullmhaítear na ráitis airgeadais faoi réir choinbhinsiún an chostais stairiúil, faoi réir dhlí infheidhmthe agus an Chleachtas Cuntasaíochta a bhfuil Gnáth-Ghlacadh leis in Éirinn, ar a n-áirítear géilliúntas do chaighdeán tuairiscithe airgeadais de chuid na Comhairle um Thuairisciú Airgeadais mar atá á bhfógairt ag Institiúid na gCuntasóirí Cairte in Éirinn.

Mí Dheireadh Fómhair 2013, d’fhógair an Roinn Chaiteachais Phoiblí agus Athchóirithe go raibh Príomh-Chranchnuir Éireann Teoranta piochta mar an rogha iarrthóra don chéad Cheadúnas eile don Chranchnuir Náisiúnta, a mbeidh feidhm leis ar feadh tréimhse 20 bliain. Síndodh an cheadúnas nua ar 27 Feabhra 2014 agus, i ndiaidh tréimhse trasdula, thosaigh Príomh-Chranchnuir Éireann Teoranta mar oibritheoir an Chranchnuir Náisiúnta faoin a cheadúnas nua. D’éirigh an Comhlacht as bheith ag trádáil ar 29 Samhain 2014. I bhfianaise na n-imeachtaí seo rinne na Stiúrthóirí machnamh faoin mbonn cuntasaíochta agus shocraíodar go mbeadh sé cuí go n-ullmhófaí na ráitis airgeadais ar bhonn foircinn a léireodh an fhíríc nach raibh ceadúnas an Chranchnuir Náisiúnta a thuilleadh ag an gComhlacht ar an dáta sin, rud a chiallaíonn go léirítear sócmhainní agus dliteannais ag na glan-mhéideanna ag a raibh siad in-aisghabhála nó iníoctha agus tá soláthar déanta do na costais a ghabhann le trasdul an Cheadúnais chuig Príomh-Chranchnuir Éireann Teoranta.

Consequently, assets have been stated at their estimated recoverable amounts and full provision has been made for costs associated with the transfer of operations to the new operator and for the costs that the company is expected to incur in a winding up process as provided for under the National Lottery Act, 2013.

The comparatives relating to the year ended 31 December 2013 have been prepared on a going concern basis as the financial statements relating to that year had been approved and finalised prior to completion of the transition process. Aside from the above, the following accounting policies have been applied to the company's continued trade to 31 December 2014:

b) Turnover

Turnover from the sale of National Lottery tickets has been recognised as the tickets were sold with adjustments being made for games yet to be held. All turnover is derived from and originates in Ireland.

c) Prizes

The prize structure complies with the requirements of Section 4(2) of the National Lottery Act, 1986 whereby, taking one year with another, not less than 40% of the total monies received by the Company in respect of the sale of National Lottery tickets shall be distributed in prizes. Prizes have been provided for as revenue is recognised on the basis of the game's particular prize structure.

d) Advertising and Promotional Expenditure

Advertising and promotional expenditure is written off in full in the year in which the costs are incurred.

e) Leased Assets - Operating

Operating lease rentals and associated costs have been provided for as appropriate.

f) Taxation

The Company is exempt from Corporation Tax under Section 220 Taxes Consolidation Act, 1997.

g) Fixed Assets - Tangible Assets

The cost of tangible fixed assets is reimbursed out of the National Lottery Fund. Accordingly, no depreciation has been provided.

Under Section 17(1) (a) of the National Lottery Act, 1986, the Company held these assets in trust for the State. Under the new licence, these assets have been made available to the new operator and consequently are not reflected in the financial statements.

Dá réir sin, léirítear sócmhainní ag a méideanna measta in-aisghabhála agus tá soláthar iomlán déanta do na costais a ghabhann le trasdul an chomhlachta go dtí an t-oibritheoir nua agus do na costais a mheastar a thitfidh ar an gcomhlacht agus é i mbun próiseas foircinn, a bhfuil soláthar dó faoin Acht um Chrannchuir Náisiúnta, 2013. Réitíodh na comparáidí a bhaineann leis an mbliain dar críoch 31 Nollaig 2013 ar bhonn ghnó leantaigh ón uair go raibh na ráitis airgeadais a bhaineann leis an mbliain úd faofa agus críochnaithe roimh chríochnú don phróiseas foircinn.

Seachas a bhfuil thuas, cuireadh na polasaithe cuntasaíochta seo a leanas i bhfeidhm i leith thrádáil an Chomhlachta, a lean go dtí 31 Nollaig 2014.

b) Láimhdeachas

Aithníodh láimhdeachas ó dhíolachán thicéid an Chrannchuir Náisiúnta de réir mar a d'íoladh na ticéid agus coigeartú déanta do chluichí atá fós le himirt.

Cineann an láimhdeachas uile in Éirinn agus is mar thoradh ar thionscnamh Éireannach é.

c) Duaiseanna

Comhlíonann an struchtúr duaise forálacha Alt 4(2) den Acht um Chrannchuir Náisiúnta, 1986, mar atá sé leagtha síos nach scaipfear níos lú ná 40% d'iomlán an airgid a fhaigheann an Comhlacht, mar thoradh ar dhíolachán thicéid an Charannchuir Náisiúnta, mar dhuaiseanna - agus bliain amháin á glacadh le ceann eile. Rinneadh soláthar do dhuaiseanna de réir struchtúr duaise gach cluiche ar leith faoi mar a aithníodh teacht isteach.

d) Caiteachas ar Fhógraíocht is ar Phromóisin

All exchange differences are dealt with in the Profit and Loss Account.

Up to the date on which staff transferred to the new operator, pensions were provided to seconded staff under multi-employer defined benefit superannuation schemes which were administered by the Company's parent, An Post, and a defined contribution scheme. In relation to the defined contribution scheme, contributions were accrued and recognised in operating profit or loss in the period in which they are earned by the relevant staff.

Due to the seconded nature of staff, the Company was unable to identify its share of the underlying assets and liabilities in the defined benefit scheme attributable to the Company on a consistent and reasonable basis. Because of this, as permitted by FRS 17, the defined benefit schemes were accounted for by the Company as if the schemes were defined contribution schemes.

7. Impact of completion of current National Lottery licence

In October 2013, the Department of Public Expenditure and Reform announced that Premier Lotteries Ireland had been selected as the preferred applicant for the next National Lottery Licence which will be in place for a 20 year period. The new licence was signed on 27 February 2014 and Premier Lotteries Ireland commenced operations on 30 November 2014.

As part of the transition process, certain staff availed of a voluntary severance/early retirement scheme and the remaining staff transferred to the new operator under the Transfer of Undertakings Protection legislation. Also, in accordance with the terms of the new licence, the liability for payment of prizes not claimed at 29 November 2014 was transferred to Premier Lotteries Ireland. Consequently, the prize liability amounts at that date were offset against the amount owed by the National Lottery Fund and Premier Lotteries were funded by the National Lottery Fund for the payment of these prize liabilities.

An Post National Lottery Company ceased as operator of the National Lottery on that date and €9.5m has been provided for all costs incurred in effecting the transfer of operations to Premier Lotteries Ireland, the cost of continuing to operate systems for a period after 29th November and those costs expected to be incurred in the wind up of An Post National Lottery Company.

17. Pensions

The pension entitlements of staff arose under a number of An Post externally funded defined benefit and defined contribution pension schemes, the assets of which are vested in independent trustees appointed by An Post for the sole benefit of employees and their dependants.

An Post operates multi-employer defined benefit schemes. Due to the seconded nature of staff, the Company is unable to identify the share of the underlying assets and liabilities in the schemes, which may be attributable to the Company, on a consistent and reasonable basis. Because of this, as permitted by FRS17, the schemes have been accounted for by the Company as if the schemes were defined contribution schemes.

The pension costs of the An Post defined benefit schemes are assessed in accordance with the advice of an independent professionally qualified actuary. The most recent actuarial valuations were carried out at 1 January, 2013, using the attained age method and disclosed that the assets of the schemes at that date were sufficient to cover 92% of the accrued liabilities after allowing for expected future increases in pensionable remuneration. The actuarial valuation of 1 January 2013 recommended a contribution rate of 14.4% of pensionable remuneration. The scheme assets were stated at their market value at that date. The net pension liabilities of the pension schemes at 31 December 2013 amounted to €440 million. The actuarial valuations are not available for public inspection but the results have been advised to the members of the schemes. These pension arrangements transferred with the relevant staff on the termination of the licence on 29 November 2014.

Employer contributions to the defined contribution scheme were at rates varying between 5% and 9% of pensionable remuneration.

The total pension cost in respect of the Company for the year ended 31 December 2014 was €785,000 (2013: €864,000).

20. Group Membership and Controlling Party

An Post holds 80% of the issued share capital of the Company.

The sole activity of the Company was the operation of the National Lottery under Licence from the Minister for Public Expenditure and Reform in accordance with the provisions of the National Lottery Act, 1986. The licence expired on 29 November, 2014 when Premier Lotteries commenced as operator under the new licence. The surplus generated during the period to 29 November, 2014 is entirely attributable to the National Lottery Fund and accordingly, the results of the Company are not consolidated within the An Post Group. The Company was managed and controlled throughout the year by the Directors on behalf of An Post and the ultimate controlling party, the Minister for Public Expenditure and Reform.

An Post also provided agency services to the Company whereby An Post makes sales and pays prizes on behalf of the Company in accordance with the standard terms and conditions and remuneration structure common to all of the Company's agents.

Excluding staff costs (Note 8) and including the Management Fee, expenses for the year in respect of services provided by An Post Group undertakings to the Company amounted to €4,504,000 (2013: €5,160,000).
