# "90 Bingo" INTERACTIVE INSTANT WIN GAME



The Regulator has granted a licence to Premier Lotteries Ireland Designated Activity Company authorising it to hold the National Lottery on the Minister's behalf, in accordance with the National Lottery Act 2013.

#### The National Lottery

Rules for Interactive Instant Win Game "90 Bingo"

#### A. GENERAL

- 1) These are the Interactive Instant Win Game Specific Rules for the Game called "90 Bingo" (hereinafter known as the "Specific Rules") which will be operated by the National Lottery.
- 2) The General Rules for Account Management and Interactive Instant Win Games contain the general rules which apply to all Interactive Instant Win Games. For further information, please click <u>here</u>. Additionally, both sets of rules can be obtained from Lottery Headquarters.
- 3) When you play "90 Bingo", these Specific Rules, the General Rules for Account Management and Interactive Instant Win Games, the Account Terms and the Data Privacy Statement apply. If there is any conflict or inconsistency between these Specific Rules and the General Rules for Account Management and Interactive Instant Win Games, these Specific Rules will prevail (unless the Company states otherwise).
- 4) The Game will commence on the date it is made available on the Interactive Channels and will remain available until such time as it is removed from the Interactive Channels. The Company reserves the right to recommence the Game at any time and for such duration as the Company decides at its sole discretion.
- 5) These Specific Rules have been approved by the Regulator in accordance with Section 45 of the Act.

- 8) Where the context so requires, in these Specific Rules, the neutral gender shall include the feminine or masculine gender and vice versa, the feminine gender shall include the masculine gender and vice-versa and the singular shall include the plural and vice-versa.
- 9) Capitalised words and expressions defined in the General Rules for Account Management and Interactive Instant Win Games or the Account Terms but not herein shall have the same meanings as those set out in the General Rules for Account Management and Interactive Instant Win Games or the Account Terms when used herein.

#### **B. COST OF PLAY**

1) The price of a "90 Bingo" play will be €5

#### C. HOW TO PLAY "90 BINGO"

1) The Player chooses the "90 BINGO" Game by clicking on the "Play" link on the Game Play Window. The opening screen below is then displayed.



2) The Player clicks 'Play' to continue. The Player is presented with a screen displaying six 'Bingo Cards' and a Bingo machine. Each 'Bingo Card' displays fifteen numbers from the range 1 to 90.



- 3) The aim of the Game is to complete one horizontal 'LINE', two horizontal 'LINES' or a 'FULL HOUSE' (three horizontal 'LINES') on an individual 'Bingo Card' to win a prize. The prize won is revealed on the relevant 'Bingo Card(s)' at the end of the Game.
- 4) The Player must tap the 'LET'S PLAY BINGO' button on the Bingo machine to commence the Bingo draw and start the Game. This button will animate after a short period of inactivity to prompt the Player to tap it.

- 5) During the draw, fifty balls are drawn from the Bingo machine one by one, and displayed in the holding area to the left and right of the Bingo machine. The matching numbers are then automatically marked off on the 'Bingo Cards'.
- 6) The Player may win a Prize on each individual 'Bingo Card' in which case he/she will be entitled to the sum of all Prizes won.
- 7) Once the Player has played, a message indicating the result will appear:

- 8) The Player is required to acknowledge this message by clicking the "FINISH" button.
- 9) The Game then ends, and the Player is presented with a screen confirming the outcome.

# E. PRIZE AMOUNTS, NUMBER OF PRIZES AND ODDS OF WINNING VARIOUS PRIZES

- 1) The prize table that is set out below provides details on the Prizes that are available to win in "90 Bingo" and the odds of winning same.
- 2) The determination of whether or not a Player has won a Prize (and the level of any such Prize) is randomly determined by the Central Gaming System at the point of purchase of the Play.
