Rules for Scratch Card Game “Wanderlust”

A. GENERAL

- 1) These are the Scratch Card Game Specific Rules for the Game called “Wanderlust” (hereinafter known as the “**Specific Rules**”) which will be operated by the National Lottery.
- 2) The Scratch Card Game General Rules contain the general rules which apply to all Scratch Card Games. For further information, please click [here](#). Additionally, both sets of rules can be obtained from Lottery Headquarters.
- 3) When you play “Wanderlust” these Specific Rules and the Scratch Card Game General Rules apply. If there is any conflict or inconsistency between these Specific Rules and the Scratch Card Game General Rules these Specific Rules will prevail (unless the Company states otherwise).
- 4) The Game will commence on a date to be announced and will continue until the Game End Date.
- 5) These Specific Rules have been approved by the Regulator in accordance with Section 45 of the Act.

- 8) Where the context so requires, in these Specific Rules, the neutral gender shall include the feminine or masculine gender and vice versa, the feminine gender shall include the masculine gender and vice-versa and the singular shall include the plural and vice-versa.
- 9) Capitalised words and expressions defined in the Scratch Card Game General Rules but not herein shall have the same meanings as those set out in the Scratch Card Game General Rules when used herein.

B. DEFINITIONS

The following words and terms will have the following meanings unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:

- 1) **Instant Prize** means the prize that is won when either three identical cash amounts or three  symbols are revealed in the Play Area on a Ticket.

- 2) **Play Symbols** mean the cash amounts and plane symbol/symbols which appear in the Play Area along with their matching captions. These cash amounts and plane symbol/symbols will be derived from the following sets:






- 3) **Prize Percentage** means the total value of all Instant Prizes that are available to win in the Game as a percentage of the value of all Tickets in the Game.

C. COST OF PLAY

- 1) The price of a “Wanderlust” Ticket will be €3.

D. HOW TO PLAY “WANDERLUST”

- 1) The owner of a Ticket containing three  amounts in the Play Area on a Ticket shall be entitled to an Instant Prize of €1,000.
- 2) The owner of a Ticket containing three  amounts in the Play Area on a Ticket shall be entitled to an Instant Prize of €100.
- 3) The owner of a Ticket containing three  amounts in the Play Area on a Ticket shall be entitled to an Instant Prize of €20.
- 4) The owner of a Ticket containing three  amounts in the Play Area on a Ticket shall be entitled to an Instant Prize of €5.
- 5) The owner of a Ticket containing three  amounts in the Play Area on a Ticket shall be entitled to an Instant Prize of €3.
- 6) The owner of a Ticket who reveals three  symbols in the Play Area on a Ticket from “Wanderlust” shall be entitled to a commodity voucher to the value of €10,000. No cash alternative is available for a commodity voucher. The commodity voucher may be redeemed for one of a range of holiday experiences to the value of €10,000 offered by Black Tomato (unique travel experience specialists), see www.lottery.ie for further information.
- 7) In any event, only the highest value Prize shall be awarded on a winning Ticket, provided that the Ticket otherwise meets the criteria established in the section relating to Ticket validation.

E. TICKET VALIDATION

- 1) To be a valid “Wanderlust” National Lottery Ticket in addition to the general conditions on Ticket validation set out in the Scratch Card Game General Rules ([click here](#)) the following specific conditions must be met:
- 2) Exactly eight Play Symbols and their matching captions must appear in the Play Area.
- 3) Each of the Play Symbols and their matching captions must be present in their entirety, must be fully legible and must be printed in grey/black ink;
- 4) Each of the Play Symbols and its caption appearing on the Ticket must be printed in accordance with the official font schedule for “Wanderlust” as agreed between the Company and the Ticket manufacturer;
- 5) The Validation/Security Number must be printed in accordance with the official font schedule for “Wanderlust” as agreed between the Company and the Ticket manufacturer;
- 6) The Game/Book/Ticket Number must be printed in accordance with the official font schedule for “Wanderlust” as agreed between the Company and the Ticket manufacturer.

F. HOW TO CLAIM PRIZES

- 2) Instant Prizes of a €10,000 commodity voucher may be redeemed in exchange for a completed winning Ticket and following the Ticket validation procedure at Lottery Headquarters or by posting the signed Ticket complete with name and address to Lottery Headquarters at the claimant’s sole risk (a

copy of suitable Photo ID (e.g. current passport, current driving licence etc.) must be included).

- 3) Instant Prizes of a €10,000 commodity voucher may be transferred to another person aged eighteen years of age or over with the consent of the Ticket owner. A holiday experience must be booked within twelve months of the date of a commodity voucher prize claim and the value of the commodity voucher must be fully redeemed within twenty four months of the date of the commodity voucher prize claim.
- 4) The End Claim Date for this Game is 29th September, 2023.

G. PRIZE AMOUNTS, NUMBER OF PRIZES AND ODDS OF WINNING VARIOUS PRIZES

- 1) The prize table that is set out below provides details on the Instant Prizes that are available to win in “Wanderlust” and the odds of winning an Instant Prize.
- 2) At time of purchase some Instant Prizes may have already been won.
- 3) The figures below are based on a complete sale of all Tickets in the game. The Company may, at its discretion, extend the scale of a game by putting on sale a full reprint of the game or a larger or smaller version in direct proportion to the structure set out in the table below:
